

#### DOING THE LITTLE THINGS RIGHT



The Buccaneers rank No. 1 in the NFL with a +8 turnover margin in 2023.

The Buccaneers and Texans have been two of the league's best at taking care of the ball this season. Tampa Bay has turned the ball over just six times in seven games played - tied for the second-fewest in the NFL.

Meanwhile, the Buccaneers have also been opportunistic on the defensive side of the ball, generating 13 takeaways through the team's first seven games, which stand tied for the fourth-most in the NFL.

# OFFENSIVE NOTES

#### A CONSISTENTLY-DOMINANT DUO

· Mike Evans (1,124) and Chris Godwin (1,023) each surpassed the 1,000-yard receiving mark last season, marking the fourth time in franchise history that multiple Buccaneers surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in the same season (2014, 2019, 2021, 2022). Evans and Godwin have accounted for the past three such occasions.



· Evans and Godwin were 1-of-5 sets of teammates last season to go over 1,000 yards each.

#### PROFICIENCY IN PASS PROTECTION

· Since the arrival of All-Pro tackle Tristan Wirfs in 2020, Tampa Bay ranks first in sacks allowed per pass attempt (3.2%) and leads the NFL in most games without allowing a sack (17). So far in 2023, the Buccaneers have allowed just 11 sacks through Week 8.

- The Buccaneers offensive line is tied for third in the league lead in fewest quarterback hits allowed this season (32), the second-fewest sacks (11) and ranks fourth in fewest sacks allowed per pass attempt (4.3%).
- When Baker Mayfield has faced pressure, he ranks second among all QBs this season in passer rating and fifth in completion percentage.

#### RAISING THE LEVEL IN THE REDZONE



- $\cdot$  Through Week 8, Tampa Bay has allowed its opponents to reach the end zone on just 27.3% of redzone drives, the best defensive mark in the NFL this season. Tampa Bay's six redzone touchdowns allowed are also the fewest in the NFL this season.
- The Buccaneers have three takeaways inside the redzone, which are tied for the second-most in the NFL this season.

#### A DO-IT-ALL SAFETY



- · Antoine Winfield Jr. is tied for second in the league with three forced fumbles this season, establishing a new single-season career high.
- · Winfield Jr. joins Steelers edge rusher T.J. Watt as the only players this season with multiple forced fumbles, multiple fumble recoveries

and multiple sacks.

### NATIONAL COACHING ACADEMY

- $\cdot$  On Tuesday, the Tampa Bay Buccaneers established a coaching academy that delivers an intensive, comprehensive curriculum and opportunity to participate in the team's 2024 rookie minicamp for coaching candidates seeking their first entry into the NFL.
- The Tampa Bay Buccaneers National Coaching Academy is open to all persons with three or more years of coaching or work experience in a football program at the high school, college or semi-professional league level, irrespective of background or status. Twenty-five finalists will be selected from a nationwide search and participants will be awarded full scholarships to cover costs in Tampa for the weeklong Academy.
- The inaugural class will receive valuable on-field experience, interactive sessions, business insights, media training, film review, and instruction on key football software with NFL players, coaches and staff. Participants will be given hands-on instruction as well as valuable networking opportunities with Buccaneers coaches and staff members throughout the organization. The Academy complements the NFL's long-established Bill Walsh Diversity Coaching Fellowship, created in 1987, to open pathways for minority coaches into the league.

### **MIKE EVANS**

- Needs 1 receiving touchdown to tie Andre Reed (87) for the 16th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs 2 receiving touchdowns to tie Don Maynard (88) for the 15th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs 3 receiving touchdowns to tie Davante Adams (90 active) for the 14th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs 19 receiving yards to surpass Joey Galloway (10,950) for the 39th-most receiving yards in NFL history.
- Needs 68 receiving yards to become the first player in team history to surpass the 11,000-yard receiving mark with the Buccaneers.
- Needs 128 receiving yards to surpass Chad Johnson (11,059) for the 38th-most receiving yards in NFL history.

### **CHRIS GODWIN**

- Needs 1 receiving touchdown to tie Jimmie Giles (34) and surpass Cameron Brate (33) for the second-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Needs 1 touchdown to surpass Jimmie Giles (34) for the fourthmost touchdowns from scrimmage in franchise history.
- Needs 16 receptions to join Mike Evans as the only players in franchise history with 500+ receptions for Tampa Bay.







## AMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Spent three seasons as Tampa Bay's defensive coordinator (2019-21) prior to being promoted to head coach on March 30, 2022.
- X Joined Jon Gruden as the only coaches in franchise history to win a division title in their first year as head coach.
- X Executed a historic defensive performance in Super Bowl LV, in which the Buccaneers held the Kansas City Chiefs to just nine points and without a touchdown.
- X Bowles has coached six different Buccaneers to Pro Bowl selections: Shaquil Barrett (2019, 2021), Jason Pierre-Paul (2020), Vita Vea (2021), Devin White (2021), Antoine Winfield Jr. (2021) and Tristan Wirfs (2022).
- X Led the NFL's top run defense in back-toback seasons from 2019-20.

DeMeco Ryans was named head coach of the Houston Texans on Jan. 31, 2023, becoming the sixth head coach in franchise history.

Ryans was named the 2022 Pro Football Writers of America Assistant Coach of the Year. He recently completed his sixth season with the San Francisco 49ers and second as the team's defensive coordinator, helping lead the team to the NFC Championship. He spent the previous three seasons (2018–20) as the 49ers inside linebackers coach, while serving as the team's defensive quality

### DEMECO RYANS AT A GLANCE

- Originally drafted in the second round (33rd overall) by the Houston Texans in the 2006 NFL Draft, Ryans played for Houston (2006-11) and the Philadelphia Eagles (2012-15).
- In his second season as defensive coordinator, the 49ers defense ranked first in total defense (300.6 yards/game), total points allowed (277) and points allowed per game (16.3) in the 2022 regular season. San Francisco's defense allowed just 37 red zone trips, the fewest in the league. Additionally, San Francisco allowed the second-fewest first downs (291) and first down yards (4.69 yards) on the season. The defense recorded 20 interceptions on the season, tied for the most in the NFL. Ryans guided a San Francisco defense that forced three-and-outs on 27.3 percent of their opportunities, fourth-highest in the NFL, while registering 44.0 sacks, tied for 10th in the league.
- In his first season as defensive coordinator in 2021, the 49ers defense allowed 310.0 total yards per game, ranking third in the NFL. San Francisco also surrendered the sixth-fewest passing yards per game (206.5). The 49ers saw eight different players record an interception on the season, while forcing 22 fumbles on defense.
- In 2020, Ryans helped the 49ers defense rank fifth in the NFL total yards allowed per game (359.0) and seventh in rush defense (118.9). The previous year, Ryans helped guide San Francisco's second-ranked defense in total yards allowed per game (281.8), the fewest total yards allowed per game by the team since 1997 (250.8). The 49ers defense also ranked first in the NFL in forced fumbles (21) and sixth in takeaways (27).
- During Ryan's career in San Francisco, Nick Bosa garnered NFL
  Defensive Rookie of the Year (2019), first-team All-Pro honors (2022)
  and three Pro Bowl selections (2019, 2021, 2022) in addition to being
  named DPOY in 2022, Fred Warner earned two first-team All-Pro
  honors (2020, 2022) and two Pro Bowl nods (2020, 2022), while
  second-year player Talanoa Hufanga also earned first-team All-Pro
  and Pro Bowl nods this past season.
- During his 10-year playing career, Ryans was named AP Defensive Rookie of the Year and PFWA Rookie of the Year in 2006, first-team All-Pro in 2007 and was selected to the Pro Bowl in 2007 and 2009.
- A native of Bessemer, Ala., Ryans played linebacker at the University of Alabama (2002-05). As a senior, he was a unanimous All-American selection, SEC Defensive Player of the Year and earned first-team All-SEC honors in 2005.
- Ryans and his wife, Jamila, have one daughter, Xia, and two sons, MJ and Micah.


