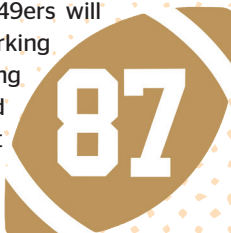

HONORING 87

- Prior to this Sunday's game vs. LAR, the 49ers will unveil two statues commemorating "The Catch" from **9:30 a.m. - 10:30 a.m.** Weighing 350-pounds each, the sculptures of Dwight Clark and Joe Montana will be placed exactly 23 yards apart, just as the two 49ers were during the famous play on January 10th, 1982. The representation of Clark, with his hands outstretched, will extend 11 feet in the air.
- 49ers CEO **Jed York**, Pro Football Hall of Famer **Joe Montana**, **Kelly Clark**, and additional **49ers alumni** including members of the Super Bowl XXIX Championship team, who will be honored Sunday as part of the team's Alumni Weekend, will be on hand.

- In addition to the statue unveiling, the 49ers will paint the playing field with an "87" marking in the north end zone commemorating the location of "The Catch." Funds raised throughout the weekend will support Clark's charity of choice, the Golden Heart Fund - established in 2016 to support 49ers alumni in need of financial, medical, psychological or emotional support.



WHAT 2 WATCH 4

- **San Francisco** looks for their second consecutive win against the Los Angeles Rams. The Niners have won four of the previous five matchups between the teams.
- The **49ers offense** has registered 400-or-more total net yds. in back-to-back weeks [447 total net yds. vs. Arz. (10/7/18) and 401 total net yds. at GB (10/15/18)]. With 400-or-more total net yds. of offense this week, San Francisco would register 400-plus total net yds. in three consecutive games for the first time since Weeks 14-16 of the 2003 season [496 vs. Arz. (12/7/03), 502 at Cin. (12/14/03) and 414 at Phi. (12/21/03)].
- The **49ers** look to score a TD on their first offensive possession of the game for the third consecutive week. It would be the first time since Weeks 1-3 of the 2014 season that the 49ers have scored on their opening possession in three straight weeks [at Dal. (9/7/14), vs. Chi. (9/14/14) and at Arz. (9/21/14)].
- With a career-high 126 rec. yds. last week at GB (10/15/18), WR **Marquise Goodwin** looks for 100-or-more rec. yds. in consecutive games for the second time in his career [106 yds. at Hou. (12/10/17) & 114 yds. vs. Ten. (12/17/17)].

THROW IT BACK

- This week vs. LAR, the 49ers will wear their much-heralded throwback uniforms from the 1994 Super Bowl season. The uniform features white jerseys and pants, the iconic drop shadow number, three stripe sleeve, black and red pant stripes, and a throwback oval decal on the sides of helmets and throwback wordmark on the front bumper of the helmets.
