PETTIS' GOLDEN NUGGETS

- Pettis' father, Gary, played Major League Baseball for 11 seasons with the California Angels (1982-87), Detroit Tigers (1988-89 & 1992), Texas Rangers (1990-91) and San Diego Padres (1992). He was a five-time Gold Glove winning center fielder and is the current third base coach for the Houston Astros.
- Set an NCAA record with nine punt return touchdowns in his career.
- Pettis' cousin, Austin Pettis, was drafted in the third round (78th overall) of the 2011 NFL Draft by the St. Louis Rams.
- His brother, Kyler, is currently an actor who is best known for his role on NBC's soap opera, Days of Our Lives.

COLLEGE

Played in 53 games (36 starts) in four years at Washington and registered 163 recepts. for 2,256 yds. and 24 TDs. Also had 90 PRs for 1,274 yds. (14.2 avg.) and 9 TDs. Set the NCAA record for career PRs for TDs (9). In 2017, was a consensus First-Team All-America selection and earned First-Team All-Pac-12 honors at both WR and return specialist. Played in 13 games (12 starts) and tallied 63 recepts. for 761 yds. and 7 TDs while adding 21 PRs for



428 yds. (20.4 avg.) and 4 TDs. Tied the NCAA record with a PR for a TD in 3 consecutive games. As a junior, played in 14 games (11 starts) and earned Second-Team All-Pac-12 honors. Recorded 53 recepts. for 822 yds. and 15 TDs. Also notched 25 PRs for 287 yds. (11.5 avg.) and 2 TDs. His 15 TD recepts. ranked as the 3rd-most in a single season in school history, 7th-most in a single season in Pac-12 history and 7th-most in the country in 2016. As a sophomore, named Second-Team All-America by *The Sporting News* as a punt returner and earned Second-Team Academic All-Pac-12 honors. Played in 13 games (8 starts) and tallied 30 recepts. for 414 yds. and 1 TD while adding 16 PRs for 271 yds. (16.9 avg.) and 2 TDs. In 2014, played in 13 games (5 starts) and registered 17 recepts. for 259 yds. and 1 TD. Also recorded 28 PRs for 288 yds. and 1 TD

- Attended JSerra Catholic (San Clemente, CA) HS, where he earned first-team All-CIF Southern Section Pac-5 Division and first-team All-Trinity League as a WR in 2013. Registered 50 recepts. for 889 yds. and 11 TDs as a senior.
- Also played basketball and was a member of the track team, where he competed in the state championships in the 200 meters and long jump.
- His father, Gary Pettis, played 11 seasons in the MLB and earned 5 Gold Gloves. Gary is currently the third base coach for the Houston Astros.
