2018 HIGHLIGHTS

• Spent the entire season on the Reserve/NFI List.

GOLDMINE

- Street's grandfather, who served in the Marine Corps, gave him advice in the first grade that would last a lifetime. He told Kentavius that no matter the circumstance, he was going to have to outwork the competition. Street states that he has taken that mindset and carried it with him everywhere he goes in the classroom, on the field, in the weight room and in the community.
- Street has a cousin, Kiwaukee Thomas, who played 8 seasons in the NFL with the Jaguars, Bills and Dolphins. After his playing career was over, Kiwaukee got into coaching, and was recently named the head football coach at Middle Georgia State University.
- One of Streets' favorite memories comes from a tightly-contested, 10-3 home victory over Notre Dame in 2016. The game was played under unique circumstances, as Hurricane Matthew had recently struck the east coast and transformed the field to a 100-yard slip and slide with a constant downpour in addition to 20-plus miles per hour winds attacking the field. "It was a battle to the very end," Street said. "It was such a fun, well-fought victory."



STREET'S GOLDEN NUGGETS

- Street's athletic ability was featured in a video of his 700-pound squat at a NC State workout, which went viral.
- Along with Bradley Chubb (Denver Broncos 5th overall), B.J. Hill (New York Giants – 69th overall) and Justin Jones (Los Angeles Chargers – 84th overall), Street became the final player from NC State's starting defensive line to be drafted in 2018. It marks the first time since 2013 that a school's complete starting defensive line was selected in the same draft (LSU – 2013).

GOLDMINE (CONTINUED)

• Street and his fellow rookies participated in the annual 49ers Mentorship Academy on September 18, 2018. The Mentorship Academy, partnering with USA Football, is a three-step program designed to provide high school football players with the opportunity to develop the skills necessary to succeed and be leaders on and off the field. The rookie class invited the high schoolers to the team facility, where they shared opinions and lessons over a meal and fun competitions.

Played in 51 games (35 starts) in four years at North Carolina State and registered 123 tackles, 19.5 TFLs, 9.5 sacks, 2 FFs, 2 FRs and 6 PDs. In 2017, started all 13 games and tallied 38 tackles, 6.5 TFLs, 3.5 sacks, 1 FF, 1 FR and 2 PDs. As a junior, played in 13 games (12 starts) and notched 31 tackles, 9.0 TFLs, 5.5 sacks, 1 FR and 1 PD. In 2015, played in 13 games (10 starts) and recorded 31 tackles, 3.0 TFLs, 0.5 sack,



1 FF and 2 PDs. As a freshman, played in 12 games and registered 23 tackles, 1.0 TFL and 1 PD.
