DIGGING UP NUGGETS FOR SAN FRANCISCO'S WEEK 3 GAME VS. THE LOS ANGELES RAMS



GOLDEN NUGGETS

- The **49ers** take on the Rams for the third time on *Thursday Night* Football and have won each of the previous two matchups between the two teams [W, 35-11 at StL (9/26/13) & W, 30-24 vs. LAR (12/2/82)].
- **San Francisco** has won each of the past three meetings between the 49ers and Rams. The Niners look for their first four-game win streak against the Rams since winning five consecutive from 11/16/08 - 11/14/10.
- With 100-or-more rushing yds. this week vs. LAR, RB Carlos Hyde would register consecutive 100-yd. rushing games for the first time in his career. He would also be the first player for the 49ers to reach that feat in consecutive regular season games since RB Frank Gore in 2014 [158 - vs. SD (12/20/14) & 144 vs. Arz. (12/28/14)].


GET OUT AND VOTE

After finishing with 15 carries for 124 yds. (8.3 avg.) last week at Sea. (9/17/17), RB Carlos Hyde is one of three RBs nominated for FedEx Ground NFI Player of the Week. Voting for this week's winners is open until Thursday at 12:00 p.m. PT at NFL.com/FedEx. Fans can also vote on Twitter using #AirAndGround and the nominee's last name. Hyde has been named FedEx Ground NFL Player of the Week once already in his career (2015 - Week 1).

Hyde led the NFL in Week 2 in rushing yds. (124), rushing avg. (8.27) (min. 10 atts.) and tied for the longest run (61 yds.).



DL Solomon Thomas is also up for an award this week after registering 4 tackles, which included a team-high 2 TFLs, and 1 QB hit at Sea. (9/17/17).
