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LOOKING AHEAD

With a Win vs. Seattle Seahawks...

- The **Niners** would move to 16-2-1 at home against NFC West opponents since 2009. The team's .861 winning pct. at home within their division ranks t-3rd in the NFL during that timespan (NE - .944; Ind. - .895; GB - .861).

- The **49ers** would improve to 8-3 all-time on Thursday nights, including a 4-1 record at home.
- The **49ers** would improve to 16-18 all-time against the Seahawks, including a 9-7 record at home.
- San Francisco** would win its sixth out of their last seven home games against Seattle.

GOLDEN NUGGETS

- With 47 rec. yds. vs. Sea., WR **Anquan Boldin** would pass WR Irving Fryar and move into 17th place all-time for most rec. yds.
- The **49ers defense** has registered 116 INTs since 2009, ranking 5th in the NFL and 3rd in the NFC during that timespan (GB - 140; NE - 125; Buf. - 120; Arz. - 119).
- With a passer rating of 100-or-more vs. Sea., QB **Colin Kaepernick** would reach that mark in three consecutive games for the second time in his career and first since 12/15/13 at TB (108.8), 12/23/13 vs. Atl. (108.6) and 12/29/13 at Arz. (111.2).
- The **49ers offense** has seen players record their first career TD receipt. in back-to-back games (TE **Garrett Celek** at NYG and WR **Quinton Patton** vs. Bal.).
- With a 53-yd. FG vs. Bal., K **Phil Dawson** set the 49ers franchise record with 11 FGs made from 50-or-more yds.
- FB **Bruce Miller** registered 3 receipts. for a career-high 89 yds. vs. Bal., including a career-long 52-yd. receipt.
- Since 2009, the **49ers defense** leads the NFL, allowing 91.2 rush-yds. per game against division opponents.

- With 100-or-more rec. yds. this week vs. Sea., **Boldin** would become the first member of the 49ers to reach that mark in three consecutive games since WR **Jerry Rice** in Weeks 15-17 of the 1995 season.

- If any member of the **49ers** records 100-or-more rec. yds. vs. Sea., it would mark the first time since 2001 that San Francisco had a player reach that mark in three consecutive games [RB Garrison Hearst - 105 yds. at Chi. (10/28/01); WR Terrell Owens - 125 yds. vs. Det. (11/4/01); WR Terrell Owens - 100 yds. vs. NO (11/11/01)].

WHAT THEY'RE SAYING

Seattle Seahawks DE Michael Bennett on T Joe Staley...

"Joe is a consummate professional. He does everything perfect. He's one of the best tackles in the NFL. You know you have your work cut out for you when you go against him. He's obviously one of the best tackles in the NFL and he's doing great this season."
