


THE PROSPECTOR DIGGING UP NUGGETS FOR SAN FRANCISCO'S WEEK 5 GAME VS. THE ARIZONA CARDINALS



KITTLE CORN

TE **George Kittle** has registered 18 recepts. for 316 yds. and 1 TD this season, leading the team in both recepts. and rec. yds.

• Last week at LAC (9/30/18), Kittle registered 6 recepts. for a gamehigh 125 yds. and 1 TD, including an 82-yd. TD recept.

• His 82-yd. TD last week was the longest TD recept. by a TE in franchise history and is the longest TD scored in the NFL this season (non-return).

• Kittle's 125 rec, yds. were a career high and the most by a 49ers TE since TE Vernon Davis registered 180 rec. yds. vs. Arz. (10/13/13).

 With 100-or-more rec. yds. this week vs. Arz. (10/7/18), Kittle would become the 3rd 49ers TE since 1970 to register consecutive games with 100-plus rec. yds. (TE Ted Kwalick in Weeks 5-6 of 1972 & TE Eric Johnson in Weeks 4-5 of 2004).

Kittle's 316 rec. yds. on the season are the 3rd-most in the NFL among TEs in 2018, while his 17.6 rec. avg. is the highest among TEs (min. 12 recepts.).

Through the first 4 weeks of the season, LB **Fred Warner** has registered 43 tackles, ranking 3rd in the NFL. With 10-or-more tackles in each of the first 4 games of his career, Warner is the first rookie since 2000 to begin his career with 4

consecutive games of at least 10 tackles, according to Gamebook Statistics.

Warner's 43 tackles through the first 4 weeks of the season are the 2nd-most by a member of the 49ers in Weeks 1-4 since 1970, according to Gamebook Statistics [LB NaVorro Bowman in 2012 (45 tackles)].

GOLDEN NUGGETS

Dating back to 2017, the **49ers** look for their 4th-consecutive win at Levi's Stadium. San Francisco looks to start the season with wins in each of their first two home games for just the 3rd time since 2000 (2009 & 2012).

The **Niners offense** is averaging 7.37 yds, per play on 1st down this season, ranking 3rd in the NFL (LAR – 7.83; NO – 7.77).

The **49ers defense** is allowing 3.66 yds. per carry on 1st down, ranking 9th in the NFL and 3rd in the NFC (Phi. – 3.12; NO – 3.43).
