- Holba served as a substitute teacher for the Shelby County School District (KY) after the Steelers waived him prior to the 2017 season. Holba got into substitute teaching after he began to look for a way to occupy his time while searching for his next team. He took the advice of his mother, DeAnn, who is also a teacher. "It was very humbling because the kids are like, 'Oh, you must not have been that good if you're back here in high school,'" Holba joked. After Jacksonville signed him two months into the school year, his students had the opportunity to watch Holba and the Jaguars hit a winning stretch and fall a few plays short of reaching Super Bowl LII. "It kind of hit me when I got there. I knew it was an amazing opportunity," Holba said. John Leeper, the director of personnel at Shelby Schools, felt the same way for his students. "A child can have a teacher in the classroom with them, a substitute teacher like Colin, and then go home that evening and sit down, finish their homework and get out the video game and get to be Colin Holba in the video game."
