DIGGING UP NUGGETS FOR SAN FRANCISCO'S WEEK 17 GAME AT THE LOS ANGELES RAMS



CAREER-HIGH WATCH

• TE **Garrett Celek** has set a career high this season with 4 rec. TDs. With 308 rec. yds., he needs 43 yds. to set a new single-season career high.

 LB Brock Coyle has set career highs in starts (9) and tackles (54) this season.

- K Robbie Gould has set a career-high with 37 made FGs this season. He needs 8 points on Sunday to tie his career high for scoring in a single-season (143 points in 2006).
- Gould's current 94.9 made FG percentage on the year would set a new career high (min. 16 FGM).
- WR Marquise Goodwin has registered career highs in recepts. (54), rec. yds. (934) and rec. avg. (17.3) in 2017.
- With 66 rec. yds. this week at LAR (12/31/17), **Goodwin** would become the 11th player in franchise history to reach 1,000-or-more rec. yds. in a single season, the 3rd since 2000 and the 1st since WR **Anquan Boldin** in 2014 [**Boldin** (2013-14), WR **Michael Crabtree** (2012) & WR **Terrell Owens** (2000-03)].
- RB Carlos Hyde has registered career highs in carries (225), recepts. (57) and rec. yds. (340) in 2017.
- Hyde's 6 rushing TDs on the season are tied for a career-high (2016), while his 1,190 yds. from scrimmage in 2017 set a new career high.
- With 296 rec. yds. on the season, FB **Kyle Juszczyk** needs 26 rec. yds. to set a new career high.
- With 31 punts downed inside the 20 this season, P
 Bradley Pinion is just 1 punt away from setting a new career high for punts downed inside the 20.

GOLDEN NUGGETS

- With 0.5 sack this week at LAR (12/31/17), LB Elvis Dumervil would join John Abraham as the only players to register at least 0.5 sack against all 32 teams in the NFL.
- The 49ers defense looks to hold their opponent under 100 yds. rushing for the 6th-consecutive game for the first time since doing so in 10-straight games in Weeks 5-15 (Week 7 Bye) of the 2011 season.
- With 1 TD recept. at LAR (12/31/17), TE Garrett Celek would become the 1st 49ers player to register at least 5 TD recepts. in a single season since WR Anquan Boldin notched 5 TDs in 2014.
- TE **George Kittle's** 415 rec. yds. are the most by a 49ers rookie TE since the merger in 1970.

OH WHAT A MONTH

- Coming into this week's game at LAR (12/31/17), the **49ers** have the longest active winning streak in the NFL (4 games).
- According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the 2017
 49ers and their 5 wins are the most by a team in NFL history that started the season 0-9.

With the win at LAR...

- San Francisco can become the first team with 10-or-more losses prior to December to go undefeated from December 1st until end of season since the 1986 Indianapolis Colts who started 0-13 prior to December and finished the season 3-0, according to the Elias Sports Bureau.
- The **Niners** would end the season on a 5-game winning streak. It would mark the longest winning streak to end a regular season by the 49ers since 2013, when San Francisco won their final 6 regular season games, and the 8th time in franchise history the 49ers would close out a regular season with a winning streak of 5-ormore games.
- Head coach Kvie Shana-

han would become the 4th rookie NFL head coach in franchise history (Buck Shaw - 1950; Frankie Albert - 1956 & George Seifert - 1989), and the 1st in the NFL since Tony Sparano in 2008, to go undefeated in the month of December.
