DIGGING UP NUGGETS FOR SAN FRANCISCO'S WEEK 2 GAME VS. THE DETROIT LIONS



## WHAT 2 WATCH 4

- Dating back to 2017, the 49ers look for their third-consecutive win at Levi's Stadium this week. With a win vs. Det., San Francisco would win three consecutive home games for the first time since 2013 [12/1/13 vs. StL (W, 23-13), 12/8/13 vs. Sea. (W, 19-17) & 12/23/13 vs. Atl. (W, 34-24)].
- With a win vs. Det., the Niners would improve to 24-10-1 all-time against the Lions at home. Including the postseason, San Francisco looks for their 13th-consecutive home victory against Detroit.
- If K Robbie Gould connects on his next FGA, he would make his 27th-consecutive FG, tying the 49ers franchise record for most consecutive FGM.

- Gould has made at least 1 FG in 21 consecutive games, dating back to 12/11/16. With 1 FGM this week vs. Det., he would tie his personal streak of consecutive games with 1-or-more FGM [10/23/05-11/26/06 (22 consecutive games)].
- With 1.5 sacks this week vs. Det., DL DeForest Buckner can tie
  the franchise record for the most sacks by a player through the
  first two weeks of the season, since sacks became an official statistic in 1982. His 2.5 sacks rank 1st in the NFC and 3rd in the NFL
  (T.J. Watt, Pit. 4.0; Von Miller, Den. 3.0).

## **GOLDEN NUGGETS**

- Last week at Min., CB Richard Sherman registered 2 tackles, 1 FR and 1 PD. His 1 PD marked the 100th of his career. His 100 PDs are the most in the NFL since Sherman entered the league in 2011.
- In QB **Jimmy Garoppolo's** 2 home starts for the 49ers in 2017, he completed 52 of 73 atts. (71.2%) for 623 yds. and 3 TDs as well as 1 rushing TD.

## **ROOKIE WATCH**

- Last week at Min., T Mike McGlinchey became the first 49ers rookie offensive lineman to start in Week 1 since T Anthony Davis and G Mike lupati each started in Week 1 at Sea. (9/12/10).
- In Week 1 at Min., WR **Dante Pettis** registered 2 recepts. for 61 yds. (30.5 avg.) and 1 TD. His 61 rec. yds. were the 2nd-most by a rookie in Week 1, behind Seahawks TE Will Dissly (105 rec. yds.). Pettis and Dissly were each drafted out of the University of Washington in 2018.

- Pettis was 1 of 3 rookies to register 1 rec. TD in Week 1 (Will Dissly, Sea. - 1 TD; Phillip Lindsay, Den. - 1 TD).
- According to the Elias Sports Bureau, Pettis' 22-yd. TD recept. on his first career recept. marked the first time a member of the 49ers saw their first career recept. result in a TD since TE Vernon Davis on 9/10/06 at Arz. (31-yd. TD recept.).
- Making his start in his NFL debut last week at Min., rookie LB Fred
   Warner was the only NFL defender in Week 1 to register at least
   10 tackles (12), 1 FF and 1 PD, according to Gamebook Statistics.
