LOOKING AHEAD

With a Win vs. Los Angeles...

- The **49ers** would improve to 67-64-3 all-time against the Rams, including a 34-32-2 record at home.
- The **Niners** would win their sixth consecutive season opener for the first time in franchise history.
- Head coach **Chip Kelly** would earn his third victory to open a season as a head coach in the NFL.
- **Kelly** would improve his record to 5-1 as a head coach on *Monday Night Football*.
- The **49ers** would win their 48th career game on *Monday Night Football*. The team's current 47 wins on *MNF* are the most in NFL history.

MONDAY NIGHT FLASHBACK

- RB **Carlos Hyde** has registered 218 yds. and 3 TDs in his two career season-opening games. In last season's opener, he set the 49ers franchise record for the most rushing yds. in a running back's first start with the team, going for 168 yds. vs. Min. (9/14/15).

- **Hyde's** 218 combined rushing yds. in the past two season openers are the 2nd-most in the NFL (Matt Forte, NYJ - 223 yds.).



20-POINT BENCHMARK

- In head coach **Chip Kelly's** three seasons in Philadelphia, the Eagles reached 20-or-more points 37 times out of 47 regular season games, the 3rd-most in the NFL during that timespan. In those games, the Eagles went 26-11 (.703 winning pct.).

MOST GAMES WITH 20+ PTS., 2013-15



- Since 2010, the **49ers** have scored 20-or-more points 54 times out of 96 regular season games. In those 54 games, they have a 45-8-1 record (.843 winning pct.). Their .843 winning pct. when scoring 20-or-more points ranks 3rd in the NFL during that timespan.
