

Fan voting for the 2019 Pro Bowl will continue online and on web-enabled mobile phones at <u>NFL.com/</u> <u>ProBowlVote</u> until **Thurs**day, December 13. Fans



can vote directly on Twitter, by tweeting the first and last name of the player, the player's official Twitter handle, or a hashtag including the player's first and last name. All three of these methods must include the hashtag: #ProBowIVote. Voting via Twitter is in addition to the online ballot, which will be available throughout the entire voting period.

Pro Bowl rosters will be announced on **Tuesday, December 18** live on NFL Network's Pro Bowl special "NFL Total Access: Pro Bowl Players Revealed" at 5:00 PM PT.

DL **DeForest Buckner** has registered a career-high 9.0 sacks, ranking 2nd in the NFL among DTs (Aaron Donald, LAR - 16.5). His 9.0 sacks on the season rank t-15th in the NFL.

• K **Robbie Gould** ranks t-3rd in the NFC with 25 FGM this season. He has connected on 25 of 26 FGAs on the season. His 96.2 made FG percentage ranks t-2nd in the NFL.

• TE **George Kittle's** 1,103 rec. yds. on the season rank 2nd in the NFL among TEs and 10th among all players.

• Kittle has 708 rec. yds. after the catch, the 2nd-most in the NFL among all players.

With 1 TD recept. this week vs. Sea. (12/16/18), WR **Dante Pettis** would move into sole possession of 2nd place in franchise history for TD recepts. by a rookie. With 100-or-more rec.

yds. against the Seahawks, Pettis would become the third 49ers rookie to register multiple 100-yd. receiving games in a single season (E Dave Parks - 1964 & WR Jerry Rice - 1985).

With 300-or-more passing yds. this week vs. Sea., QB **Nick Mullens** would become the first 49ers QB to pass for at least 300 yds. in three-consecutive games since QB Jeff Garcia accomplished the feat during Weeks 14-16 of the 2000 season.

With 1 point this week, K **Robbie Gould** would become the 23rd kicker in NFL history to register at least 1,500 points.

**San Francisco** has registered 5 games this season that a player has registered 100-or-more rec. yds., the second-consecutive season that they accomplished the feat and the first time since 2001-02 that they have registered at least 5 games with a 100-yd. receiver in back-to-back seasons. If the 49ers register a 100-yd. receiver this week, it would mark the first time since 2001 (7) that they would have at least 6 games with a 100-yd. receiver.

The last time the **49ers** had a 100-yd. receiver in three-consecutive games was Weeks 4-9 of the 2001 season (Week 6 Bye).

This week vs. Sea., the **49ers** are taking part in the NFL's **My Cause, My Cleats** initiative where more than 30 players and general manager **John Lynch** will be representing different charitable organizations that are important to them on speciallydesigned cleats.
