- During the 2019 offseason, members of the 49ers took part in the Second Annual Picnic on the Field, located on the Levi's Stadium field. Breida and his teammates spent the day taking pictures with fans, who enjoyed music, food and games in support of the 49ers Foundation. The foundation, in conjunction with NFL Huddle for 100, partnered with Amazon to fill 1,000 backpacks full of school supplies. Fans and players joined together to assemble the packs, which were distributed throughout the community to children in need.



- As a senior in 2016, despite receiving consideration for multiple national athletic awards which included the watch list for both the Doak Walker Award and Maxwell Award, it was an award for what he does off the field that Breida felt most honored by. Breida was announced as a finalist for the 2016 Senior Class Award after making the Georgia Southern Eagles' Honor Roll and being involved in the community by reading and speaking to local elementary schools in Statesboro, GA, as well as back home in Florida. "One of the best people I've ever been around," said Georgia Southern Head Coach Tyson Summers when asked about Breida. The 2016 Senior Class Award is given to a senior who has various notable achievements in four areas: community, classroom, character, and competition. "For them to see me as one of the role models was pretty cool for me," said Breida.

That's mom and dad to me. I would do anything for them."

- Played in 14 games (13 starts) and set single-season career highs in rushing atts. (153), rushing yds. (814), rushing TDs (3), receipts. (27), rec. yds. (261) and rec. TDs (2) before being placed on the Injured Reserve List on 12/29.
- Rushed for a career-high 138 yds. and 1 TD on 11 carries (12.5 avg.) vs. Det. (9/16), including a career-long 66-yd. TD run, while also adding 3 receipts. for 21 yds. Breida's 12.5 avg. is the 3rd-best single-game rushing avg. in franchise history (min. 10 atts.).

- His 66-yd. TD run vs. Det. (9/16) marked the longest run by a member of the 49ers since QB Colin Kaepernick registered a 90-yd. TD run vs. SD (12/20/14).
- Registered 159 yds. from scrimmage (138 rushing yds. and 21 rec. yds.) vs. Det. (9/16) on 14 touches. His 11.4 yds. per touch ranks 7th among all RBs for a single game in franchise history and is the highest avg. since 9/20/09 [RB Frank Gore - 11.7 avg. (207 rushing yds. and 39 rec. yds.) on 21 touches vs. Sea.].
- Registered a career-high 17 carries for 101 yds. and 1 TD, while adding 3 receipts. for 31 yds. and 1 TD vs. NYG (11/12). Became the first member of the 49ers to register at least 1 rushing TD and 1 rec. TD in the same game since 2014 [WR Bruce Ellington vs. SD (12/20/14)].
- Carried the ball 14 times for 106 yds. at TB (11/25), marking his 3rd career 100-yd. game. Reached 100-or-more yds. in consecutive games [101 rushing yds. vs. NYG (11/12/18)] for the first time in his career and became the first member of the 49ers to register at least 100 yds. rushing in consecutive games since RB Frank Gore in 2014 [158 rushing yds. vs. SD (12/20/14) & 144 rushing yds. vs. Arz. (12/28/14)].
- Hauled in 3 receipts. for a career-high 51 rec. yds. at Sea. (12/2).

2017

- Played in all 16 games and recorded 105 carries for 465 yds. and 2 TDs while also notching 21 receipts. for 180 yds. and 1 TD.
- Registered 4 receipts. for 39 yds. and his 1st career TD on a 21-yd. TD pass from QB C.J. Beathard at Phi. (10/29). He became the 1st 49ers rookie RB with a TD receipt. since 2001 [RB Kevan Barlow - vs. NO (11/11/01)].
- Notched his 1st career rushing TD on a 33-yd. TD run vs. NYG (11/12). Finished the game with 9 carries for 55 yds. and 1 TD. His 33-yd. TD marked the longest TD run by the team this season.
- Rushed for a then-career-high 74 yds. and 1 TD on 11 carries vs. Jax. (12/24). His 30-yd. TD run in the 4th qtr. marked his 2nd rushing TD of the season.
- Had 12 carries for 72 yds. while adding a career-long 32-yd. receipt. at LAR (12/31).

COLLEGE

Appeared in 48 games (36 starts) during his four-year career at Georgia Southern. Rushed for 3,754 yds. and 37 TDs on 543 carries, while adding 22 receipts. for 156 yds. and 3 TDs. As a senior, appeared in 12 games (11 starts) and registered 168 carries for 646 yds. and 3 TDs in addition to 11 receipts. for 53 yds. and 2 TDs. In 2015, started all 13 games and led the team with 1,608 yds. and 17 TDs on 203 carries to earn First-Team All-Sun Belt honors. As a sophomore, started all 12 games and was named First-Team All-Sun Belt. Led the Sun Belt Conference with 1,485 rush yds. while adding 17 TDs. on 171 carries. Appeared in 11 games as a freshman in 2013 and totaled 1 att. for 15 yds.
