LOOKING AHEAD

With a Win at Chicago...

- The **49ers** would improve to 33-30-1 all-time against the Bears, including an 11-17-1 record on the road.
- **San Francisco** would win three of the last four overall matchups between the two clubs.
- The **Niners** would win in Chicago for the first time since defeating the Bears, 28-3, on 1/8/89 in the NFC Championship as the 49ers went on to defeat the Cincinnati Bengals in Super Bowl XXIII.
- The **49ers** would move to 2-1 on the season against the NFC North. The team will also travel to Detroit in Week 16.

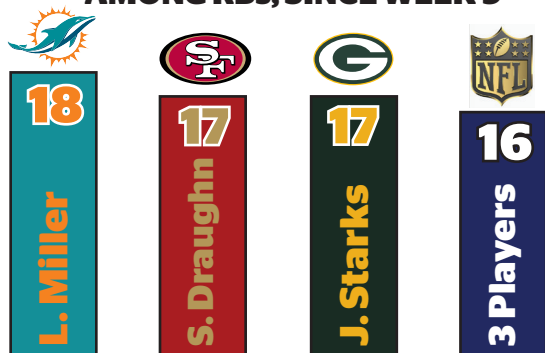
GOLDEN NUGGETS

- QB **Blaine Gabbert** will look for his third consecutive game with a QB rating of 90-or-more as he has reached the mark in back-to-back games for the first time in his career over the past two weeks [98.2 - at Sea. (11/22/15) & 94.4 - vs. Arz. (11/29/15)]. He would become the first QB to do so in 3 straight for the 49ers since QB Colin Kaepernick in 2013 [108.8 - at TB (12/15/13); 108.6 - vs. Atl. (12/23/13) & 111.2 - at Arz. (12/29/13)].
- By converting his next FGA, K **Phil Dawson** will move into sole possession of the two longest consecutive made FG streaks in 49ers franchise history. Dawson has converted 18 straight attempts this season and in 2013 he connected on a franchise record 27 straight FG atts.
- TE **Vance McDonald** is looking for a TD receipt. in his third consecutive game after hauling in a career high 6 receipts. for 71 yds. and 1 TD last week vs. Arz. (11/29/15). The week prior, McDonald caught 4 receipts. for 65 yds. and 1 TD at Sea. (11/22/15).

DRAUGHN DOES IT ALL

- RB **Shaun Draughn** has registered 259 yds. from scrimmage (146 rush & 113 rec.) in 3 games with the team for an avg. of 86.3 YPG.
- Since joining the team in Week 9, **Draughn** ranks 2nd in the NFL among RBs with 17 receipts. which includes a Week 10 Bye.

CANTON BOUND

This Sunday in Chicago, WR **Anquan Boldin** has a chance to reach numerous NFL milestones as he continues to climb the all-time leaderboards. He currently ranks 13th all-time in receipts. with 976 and 18th in NFL history with 12,871 career rec. yds.

13,000

With 36 rec. yds. at Chi., Boldin will become the 18th player in NFL history with 13,000-or-more rec. yds. in their career.

1,000

Only 10 players in NFL history have recorded 1,000-or-more receipts. in their careers. Boldin currently has 984 receipts., trailing only Cowboys TE Jason Witten (998) and Cardinals WR Larry Fitzgerald (992) among active players.

38

Boldin ranks 7th among active players with 38 career games with 100-or-more rec. yds.

50/600

With 6 receipts. and 42 yds. against Chi., Boldin will become the first player in NFL history to record 50-or-more receipts. and 600 rec. yds. in each of his first 13 seasons.



At this point in his career, Boldin has very similar stats to wide receivers who are currently enshrined in the **Hall of Fame**:
