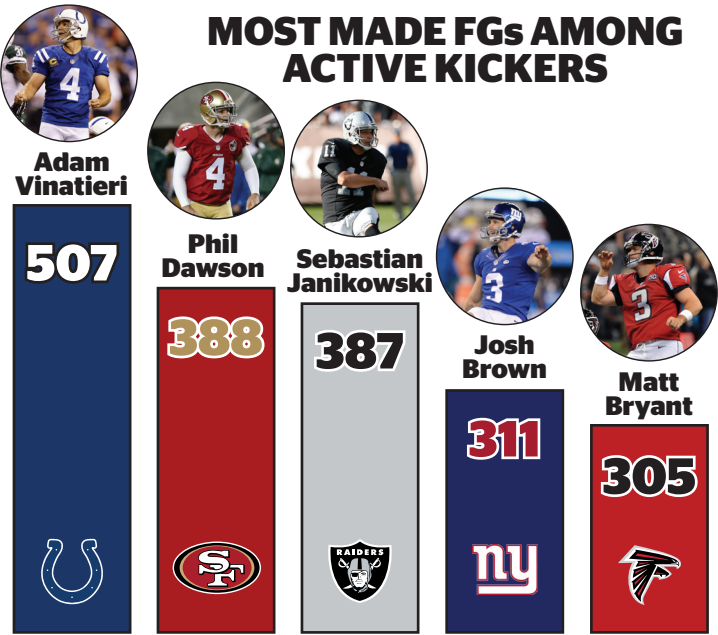

LOOKING AHEAD

- With a Win at Seattle...**
- The **49ers** would improve to 16-20 all-time against the Seahawks, including an 8-12 record on the road.
 - San Francisco** would win in Seattle for the first time since defeating the Seahawks, 19-17, on 12/24/11.
 - The **Niners** would improve to 2-0 in the team's first two divisional games of the season for the first time since 2012 [W, 13-6 vs. Sea. (10/18/12) & W, 24-3 at Arz. (10/29/12)].
 - Head coach **Chip Kelly** would even his record as a head coach against Seattle to 1-1.

PHIL UP THE RECORD BOOKS

- K **Phil Dawson** currently ranks 2nd in the NFL among active kickers with 388 career made FGs. In 2016, he looks to become just the 9th kicker in NFL history to reach 400 made FGs.

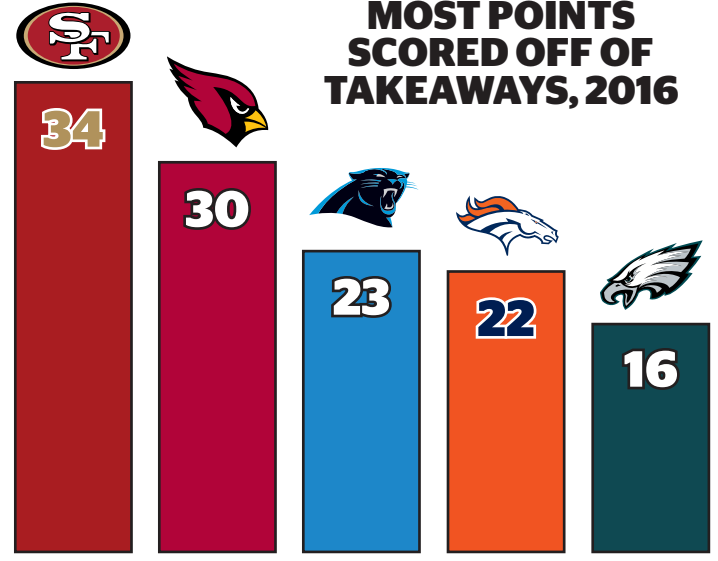


GROUND ATTACK

- Through two weeks, the **49ers offense** has rushed for 4 TDs, tied for the most in the NFL this season (Dal. - 4; Oak. - 4).
- In 2016, the **Niners** are averaging 34.0 rushing atts. per game, the 4th-most in the NFL (Car. - 34.5; Hou. - 34.5; NE - 34.5).
- With 53 yds. on the ground this season, QB **Blaine Gabbert** ranks 2nd in the NFL in rushing yds. by a QB (Cam Newton, Car. - 91).

YOUR LOSS IS OUR GAIN

- Through the first two games of 2016, **San Francisco** has forced 6 opponent turnovers (3 INTs & 3 FRs).
- The **49ers** have scored 34 pts. off of those 6 takeaways, the most in the NFL this season.



MCDONALD GOES FOR THREE STRAIGHT

- With 1 TD recept. this week at Sea., TE **Vance McDonald** would set a career-high by registering at least 1 TD recept. in three consecutive games.
- McDonald's 2 TD receipts. this season are tied for the most by a TE in the NFL through two weeks (Jack Doyle, Ind.).
- In San Francisco's last meeting at Sea. (11/22/15), McDonald caught 4 passes for 65 yds. (16.3 avg.) and 1 TD. He's looking for a rec. TD in back-to-back games at Sea.
- Dating back to last season, McDonald has registered 1 TD in 3 of his past 4 games against NFC West opponents.

THESE MEAN MORE

- As the **49ers** look for their 2nd division win of the season, they look to build on recent defensive success against the NFC West.
- Since 2009...**
- Against the NFC West, the **49ers defense** has allowed an avg. of 17.2 points per game, which ranks 3rd in the NFL.
 - Opposing NFC West QBs have averaged a passer rating of 76.0 against the **Niners**, the 4th-best in the NFL against divisional opponents.
