LOOKING AHEAD

With a Win at Arizona...

- The **49ers** would improve to 30-21 all-time against the Cardinals, including a 13-11 record on the road.
- The **Niners** would split the season series with the Cardinals for the second time in three seasons.
- **San Francisco** would move to 6-5 at University of Phoenix Stadium.
- The **49ers** would improve to 2-2 this season against NFC West opponents.

GOLDEN NUGGETS

- On the road this season, **San Francisco** has an average starting position of the 32.9-yd. line, the best in the NFL.
- The **Niners** have converted on 87.5% of their 3rd-and-1 atts., ranking 3rd in the NFL (Arz. - 92.3; NO - 88.9).
- The **49ers offense** has registered 59 rushing first downs this season, the 5th-most in the NFL (Dal. - 84; Buf. - 76; Ten. - 70; Atl. - 63). RB **Carlos Hyde** leads the team with 22 rushing first downs.
- Among QBs, **San Francisco passers** lead the NFL this season with 27 rushing first downs with 10 of those coming on third down.
- TE **Vance McDonald** is the 4th TE since the merger in 1970, and the first since 1997, to register two TD receipts. of 65-or-more yds. in the same season.

4 GOES FOR 400

- Now in his 18th NFL season and 4th with the 49ers, K **Phil Dawson** continues to climb NFL record books. With 3 made FGs this week at Arz., Dawson would become the 10th kicker in NFL history to reach 400 career made FGs.
- Going into his 57th career game with SF, if Dawson registers 9 pts. at Arz., he would be the 3rd-fastest kicker in 49ers franchise history to reach 400 total pts. scored, (Mike Cofer - 54 games; Bruce Gossett - 55 games).
- With 6 pts. against the Cardinals, Dawson would pass former 49ers RB Roger Craig (396 pts.) for the 10th-most pts. scored in franchise history.
- This season, Dawson has made 11 of his 12 FGAs (91.7%). He is on pace to record the highest single-season FG percentage of his career since 2012 as a member of the Cleveland Browns (93.5%).
- Dawson currently ranks 3rd in the NFL among active kickers with 397 career made FGs.
