

GAME NOTES



San Francisco 49ers at Kansas City Chiefs Sunday, September 23, 2018

The Rundown

- The **49ers offense** registered 178 rushing yds. and 1 TD on 29 carries (6.1 avg.). With 190 rushing yds. last week vs. Det. (9/16/18), it marks the first time since 12/20/14 [vs. SD (355 yds.)] and 12/28/14 [vs. Arz. (206 yds.)] that the 49ers registered 175-or-more rushing yds. in consecutive games.

Morris Muscles Through

- RB **Alfred Morris** registered his first rushing TD as a member of the 49ers and 33rd of his career on a 3-yd. run. He finished the game with 14 carries for 67 yds. (4.8 avg.) and 1 TD.

Juice All Alone

- FB **Kyle Juszczyk** caught a 35-yd. TD recept. from QB **Jimmy Garoppolo**. It marked Juszczyk's first TD recept. of the season, 7th of his career and the longest TD recept. of his career.

Goodwin Gets In

- WR **Marquise Goodwin** registered his first TD recept. of the season on an 11-yd. pass from Garoppolo. Goodwin now has 9 rec. TDs in his career.

49ers Convert 2-Pointer

- TE **George Kittle** helped the 49ers convert their first 2-pt. conversion since 12/24/16 at LAR (QB Colin Kaepernick run) with a recept. from Garoppolo.

The Ex Man

- Making his first start with the 49ers, DB **Antone Exum Jr.** brought down Chiefs QB Patrick Mahomes for the first sack of his career.
- **Exum** also forced a Chiefs WR Sammy Watkins fumble, marking the second FF of his career and first since 11/29/15 at Atl. as a member of the Minnesota Vikings.

Armstead Flushes Mahomes

- DL **Arik Armstead** sacked Mahomes for his first sack of the season. He now has 7.0 in his career.

Goulden Start

- K **Robbie Gould** connected on FGs from 39 and 35 yds. He has now made 31 consecutive FGAs, extending the franchise record for most consecutive made FGs.
