2018 HIGHLIGHTS

- Started all 16 games at RG, setting a new single-season career high for games started.
- Part of an offensive line that did not allow a sack on 22 passing atts. by QB Nick Mullens vs. Oak. (11/1). It marked the first time the team did not allow a sack since 12/31/17 at LAR (33 atts. - QB Jimmy Garoppolo).
- Person and the offensive line did not allow a sack on 39 atts. by QB Nick Mullens vs. NYG (11/12). It marked the first time since Weeks 3-4 of the 2000 season that the team did not allow a sack in consecutive weeks [34 atts. by QB Jeff Garcia at StL (9/17/00); 26 atts. by Garcia at Dal. (9/24/00)].

GOLDMINE

 On the same night he was drafted by the 49ers in the 7th round (239th overall) of the 2011 NFL Draft, Person was also awarded with the Montana AAU Little Sullivan Award, which is presented annually to the state of Montana's top amateur athlete. Person also became the first Bobcat selected in the NFL Draft since Joey Thomas in 2004.

PERSON'S GOLDEN NUGGET

 Comes from a football family, as his father, Jim, played at Montana Tech (1969-73) and has two uncles, Dennis Lowery (Western Montana) and Jerry Person (San Diego State) who also played collegiately.

The Bobcats led the Big Sky in scoring offense, total offense, passing offense and first downs. In 2009, started all 11 games at RT and earned First-Team All-Big Sky Honors honors. As a sophomore in 2008, started all 12 games and earned honorable mention all-conference honors, while helping the Bobcats lead the Big Sky in rushing yards and fewest sacks allowed. In 2007, started the first 8 games at RT before an injury ended his season. Redshirted in 2006.
