DIGGING UP NUGGETS FOR SAN FRANCISCO'S WEEK 3 GAME AT THE KANSAS CITY CHIEFS



GOLDEN NUGGETS

- Last week vs. Det., the **49ers offense** registered a 3-play, 97-yd. drive that resulted in RB Matt Breida's 66-yd. TD run. It marked the first time since 9/28/08 at NO that the 49ers registered a drive that went at least 97 yds. and resulted in a TD (6-play, 97-yd. drive resulting in a WR Isaac Bruce 5-yd. TD recept. from QB J.T. O'Sullivan).
- San Francisco is averaging 140.0 rushing yds. per game this season, ranking 1st in the NFC and 3rd in the NFL (Hou. 157.5; Den. 157.0).
- K Robbie Gould was named NFC Special Teams Player of the Week for the third time with the 49ers for his Week 2 performance against the Lions where he connected on FGs from 45, 42 and 36 yds. along with 3 PATs. He has made 29 consecutive FGs, setting the franchise record for most consecutive made FGs.
- According to Gamebook Statistics, RB Raheem Mostert's 5 special teams tackles are the most in the NFL this season.
