10+ PLAY DRIVES / "QUICK STRIKE" DRIVES: This season, the Jets offense has produced seven touchdowns on 10+ play drives, tied for the 10th most in the league. Over their last four games (Weeks Nine through 12), the Jets offense has produced nine drives of 10+ plays, scoring on eight of them with five touchdowns, tying for the second-most in that span.

Additionally, this season, the Jets offense has scored touchdowns on five "quick strike" drives, possessions that lasted four-or-fewer plays, tied for the ninth most in the league. Over their three-game winning streak, the Jets offense has registered three such touchdowns, tying for the second most in the league in that span.

HEADLINES CONTINUED

OFFENSIVE IMPROVEMENT: Over their last four games, the Jets offense has improved their ranking in a number of key offensive categories from the first eight weeks of the season. Over the past four games, in which the team is 3-1, the Jets have posted top 10 ranks in points per game (ranked fourth, 30.0), completion percentage (10th, 65.9%), red zone touchdown percentage (ninth, 64.3%) and sacks allowed percentage (seventh, 5.8%). Additionally, they have improved from a league-low in total offense to 13th, improving their per game average by almost 150 yards per game and from a league-low in third-down conversion percentage, improving by over 16%.

JAMAL ADAMS: In his four November games, safety **Jamal Adams** has led the NFL with 6.5 sacks, registering at least a half sack in all four games. Additionally, **Adams** has finished in the top five in both quarterback hits (10) and tackles for loss (five) in November while also scoring his second touchdown of the season.

SAM DARNOLD: In his four November games, quarterback Sam Darnold has led the team to a 3-1 record, producing an AFC leading 1,098 yards passing, while completing 66.4% of his throws with eight passing touchdowns and two rushing touchdowns, producing a quarterback rating of 107.5. For the month, he ranks in the top six among qualified AFC passers in both completion percentage and yards per attempt, while his 10 total touchdowns are tied for the second most in the conference.

BLESS AUSTIN / ARTHUR MAULET: During their three game win streak, cornerbacks **Arthur Maulet** and **Bless Austin** have allowed passer ratings of less than 70.0 when targeted (according to Radar360). **Maulet** (61.2), who first entered the starting lineup in Week 10, and **Austin** (67.8), a sixth-round rookie who was activated from Reserve/NFI in Week 10, both rank in the top 25 league wide the last three weeks in passer rating allowed.

GAMES MISSED TO INJURY: Through the first 12 weeks of the season, the Jets have lost a total of 69 games from 15 different starters this season as a result of injury, while six different starters have been placed on injured reserve and each position on the offensive line has used at least two different starters this season.

NEW YORK JETS & BERKELEY COLLEGE TEAM UP TO SERVE HOLIDAY MEALS

The New York Jets and Berkeley College teamed up with Food Bank For New York City to tackle hunger this holiday season.

First, Jets players and Berkeley College students unloaded 100+ turkeys and all the trimmings from Food Bank's tractor trailer. Then, they sliced and dice vegetables, carve the birds and serve meals to 400+ New Yorkers at a pre-Thanksgiving dinner hosted by Food Bank at their Community Kitchen in Harlem.

The group will be serving young New Yorkers and their families participating in Food Bank's Supper Klub – the city's first ever community kitchen by kids, for kids. One in five New York City children is living with hunger, and young adults – who rarely seek emergency food assistance – are more vulnerable to engaging in risky behavior to avoid going hungry.

The team and school will make a \$15,000 check presentation to the Food Bank For New York City, which will provide 75,000 meals for New Yorkers in need.

OFFENSE

WR 11 **ROBBY ANDERSON** 4th Season

Registered the second-longest offensive play in franchise history following his 92-yard touchdown catch and run vs. DAL (10/13). Recorded his 18th receiving touchdown of his career vs. OAK (11/24), tied for 16th all time in franchise history.

LT 68 **KELVIN BEACHUM** 8th Season

Team captain who has started 40 games at left tackle since joining the Jets (2017). Returned vs. NYG (11/10) after missing three games with an injury. Helped protect Sam Darnold at WAS (11/17), as the QB threw four touchdown passes, a new career high.

LG 71 **ALEX LEWIS** 4th Season

Acquired via trade during training camp, has started at left guard since Week Five. Part of an offensive line that helped pave the way for the consecutive 400-yard efforts at WAS (11/17) and vs. OAK (11/24).

C 78 **JONOTTHAN HARRISON** 3rd Season

Veteran center who joined the Jets as a free agent in 2017. Has played in 79 career games, including 36 starts. Has appeared in all 11 games this season. Helped protect QB Sam Darnold last week vs. OAK (11/24), who recorded 315 passing yards.

RG 77 **TOM COMPTON** 7th Season

Veteran offensive lineman who joined the Jets this year. Has played in 96 career games, including 32 starts. Has appeared in all 11 games this season, including starting in the victory vs. OAK (11/24) when the offense produced a season high 401 total yards.

RT 75 **CHUMA EDOGA** Rookie

Third-round selection who has started the last eight games, splitting his starts between right and left tackle. Helped protect Sam Darnold, who returned after missing three games and threw for 338 yards vs. DAL (10/13).

TE 84 **RYAN GRIFFIN** 7th Season

WR 82 **JAMISON CROWDER** 5th Season

In his first 11 games as a Jet, registered a team high 55 receptions for 580 yards. Only the second player in the NFL in 2019 to produce 75+ yards and a receiving TD in three consecutive games (Week 9-11).

WR 18 **DEMARIUS THOMAS** 10th Season

Acquired via trade prior to Week Two, the four-time Pro Bowler ranks third in receiving yards (9,712) and third in receiving touchdowns (62) among active wide receivers in the league.

QB 14 **SAM DARNOLD** 2nd Season

For the month of November, the team captain ranks in the top 10 league wide in completion pct. (66.4%), passing yards per game (274.5), yards per attempt (8.6) and QB rating (107.5), while throwing eight touchdowns and running for two more.

RB 26 **LE'VEON BELL** 6th Season

Became the fastest player (63 career games) to reach 8,000 yards from scrimmage when he surpassed the total in his first play as a Jet. Has averaged 122.2 yards per game played in his career, the second best in NFL history among all players with at least 50 games played.

KEY RESERVES

WR/RB 88 **TY MONTGOMERY** 5th Season

Unrestricted free agent signing who has seen action at both running back and wide receiver in his career. Has averaged 4.69 yards per carry since entering the league (2015).

RB 29 **BILAL POWELL** 9th Season

The team's longest-tenured player. At PHI (10/6), moved into ninth place on the franchise's all-time rushing list with 3,450 yards. Among all the rushers in the franchise's top 10 all-time rushing list, his 4.34 yards per carry rank second.

T 72 **BRANDON SHELL** 4th Season

Has started six of nine games this season at right tackle, playing left tackle following an injury to Kelvin Beachum vs. DAL (10/13). For his career, has seen action in 44 games (35 starts). Replaced an injured Chuma Edoga in the victory vs. OAK (11/24).

P 4 **LACHLAN EDWARDS** 4th Season

Set single-season franchise records in net punting average in each of the last two seasons (40.5 and 40.8), opening the 2019 season vs. BUF (9/8) by matching his single-game best with five punts inside the 20-yard line, including one downed at the two-yard line which led to a safety on the ensuing play. Has registered 100 punts inside the 20 since entering the league, the seventh most among all NFL punters.

K 9 **SAM FICKEN** 1st Season

Connected on a 38-yard field goal with 3:24 remaining in the game vs. DAL (10/13), stretching the lead to 24-16 and providing the ultimate margin of victory in the 24-22 win. At home vs. NYG (11/10), converted a 53-yard field goal, marking the longest of his career.

LS 42 **THOMAS HENNESSY** 3rd Season

Appeared in all 43 games since joining the team via trade (2017). Helped Jason Myers convert 91% of his field goal attempts en route to Myers' Pro Bowl season (2018) and helped Lachlan Edwards establish a franchise record in net punting average for the second straight season. Tied for fourth on the team in special teams tackles this season with six.

OLB 48 JORDAN JENKINS 4th Season

After missing two games, returned vs. DAL (10/13) and registered his second sack of the season. Since entering the league in 2016, is one of just 11 players with at least 10.0 sacks, five forced fumbles and five fumble recoveries. He ranks second on the team in sacks with 5.0 this season.

ILB 58 JAMES BURGESS 4th Season

Free agent signing this offseason, he is one of just four defensive backs with 25+ passes defended, 12+ quarterback hits and 12+ tackles for loss since 2016. Has scored twice on defense this year, first a safety vs. BUF (9/8) and later is first career pick six vs. OAK (11/24).

KR 17 VYNCINT SMITH 2nd Season

Joined the Jets from the HST practice squad prior to Week Four. In his Jets debut at PHI (10/6), scored on a 19-yard run, which was the first rushing touchdown by a Jets wide receiver since 2014. At MIA (11/3), Smith returned a kickoff for 78 yards, a career long and the longest return by a Jet this season.

PR 10 BRAXTON BERRIOS 2nd Season

Ranks second in the league among qualified punt returners with a 10.1 yard average this season including a season-long 26-yard return vs. OAK (11/24). On offense, reeled in a 69-yard reception vs. OAK (11/24), which set up a one-yard touchdown the following play.

JOE DOUGLAS was named general manager of the New York Jets by Christopher Johnson on June 7, 2019. In introducing him, Johnson stated that Douglas is, "The right person, at the right time," for the franchise, someone who shared Johnson's vision not just for the team, but the entire organization.

In his 20th season in the league, Douglas has put in the work and paid his dues, working as both a pro and college scout in Baltimore, Chicago and Philadelphia, and helping shape three different Super Bowl championship rosters.

"My first steps and priorities here are simply to engage and connect with the entire organization," Douglas said during his press conference. "Adam Gase and I share a vision of building a team and I look forward to partnering with him and getting this program to a place where we are consistently competing for championships each and every year.

"To Jets nation, you are getting a general manager that is a relentless worker, someone that understands a winning culture, someone that is going to strive to put a product on the field each Sunday that competes for greatness and that I hope will make you proud."

Before joining the Jets, Douglas spent the previous three seasons as the vice president of player personnel with the Eagles. In Philadelphia, he was a key component in acquiring many of the players that helped win Super Bowl LII, including the game's MVP, quarterback Nick Foles.

Using every avenue to help improve the team, Douglas was part of a front office that acquired the players who scored all but two of the team's postseason touchdowns, including four of the five touchdowns in the Super Bowl. A trio of 2017 unrestricted free agent signings - LeGarrette Blount, Foles and Alshon Jeffery - as well as a pair of street free agents - Patrick Robinson and Torrey Smith - all contributed scores on the team's title run. The Eagles' leading receiver in the Super Bowl, running back Corey Clement, was signed as an undrafted free agent, while the team's leading rusher in the game, running back Jay Ajayi, joined the club as a midseason trade.

Prior to joining the Eagles, Douglas spent a season as the director of college scouting for Chicago (2015), first working with Gase, the then offensive coordinator for the Bears.

Entering the NFL as a player personnel assistant (2000) the year Baltimore won Super Bowl XXXV, Douglas ascended within the Ravens organization, holding various posts in the organization's scouting department, serving as a national scout (2012-15), Southeast area scout (2009-11), East Coast area scout (2008) and Northeast area scout (2003-07), helping add a number of prominent players via the draft, including the Super Bowl XLVII MVP, quarterback Joe Flacco, as well as a number of Pro Bowl players - Ben Grubbs, C.J. Mosley, Justin Tucker and Marshal Yanda.

An All-Atlantic 10 selection, Douglas started 45 consecutive games at tackle for the University of Richmond. Following his collegiate playing career, he transitioned into a volunteer assistant coach role with the Spiders in 1999.

As an offensive and defensive lineman at Lee-Davis (VA) HS, Douglas was recognized as a two-time all-state honoree.

He and his wife, Shannon, have two daughters, Addison and Leighton, and a son, Thomas.

ADAM GASE was named the head coach of the New York Jets by Chairman & CEO Christopher Johnson on January 11, 2019. For Gase, he becomes the 17th full-time coach in franchise history.

Under Gase, starting quarterbacks have produced 38 games with a 100+ passer rating, a number that would tie him for 10th among all NFL franchises since 2013 – higher than the total of all three franchises he’s worked with in that span. Additionally, every quarterback (Peyton Manning, Jay Cutler, Ryan Tannehill, Matt Moore and Brock Osweiler) who has started at least two games for him has produced a 100+ passer rating performance. Since 2013 (his first season calling plays), nine different running backs have produced 100-yard games under Gase, while in his three seasons as Miami’s head coach, the Dolphins ground game averaged 4.36 yards per carry, the 10th best average in the league, and Miami running backs accounted for a 4.49 average, the third best in the league. Additionally, Dolphins running backs have 33 carries of 20+ yards in that span, tied for the fourth most in the league.

Beginning with his first season in Denver (2009), he has coached 16 different players to the Pro Bowl, including 12 offensive players — multiple players at offensive line, wide receiver and running back.

Prior to his appointment as Jets head coach, Gase spent 16 seasons as a coach in the NFL, the last six calling plays for three different franchises, including record-setting offensive output as the offensive coordinator of the Denver Broncos (2013), his first season calling plays in the NFL. In his last position, Gase spent three seasons (2016-18) as the head coach for the Miami Dolphins, where he compiled a 23-25 record and led the franchise to a postseason berth in his first season.

As the Dolphins head coach, he posted a 20-6 record in one-score games (+/- eight points), a .769 winning percentage, the best among any team in the league. Buoyed by the fact that his team registered the sixth most touchdowns in the fourth

quarter of close games (+/- seven points), Gase also saw his quarterbacks post the 10th highest passer rating in those scenarios.

In his first season under Gase’s leadership (2016), Tannehill posted the most efficient season of his NFL career, completing 67.1% of his passes for a 7.7 yards per attempt average and a 93.5 passer rating, all career highs, while also leading the league with a red zone passer rating of 119.7 as the Dolphins broke an eight-year playoff drought.

Before his time in South Florida, Gase spent a season as the offensive coordinator with the Chicago Bears (2015), improving the team’s rushing yardage ranking from No. 27 the season before to No. 11. Under his tutelage, Cutler finished the season with the highest passer rating (92.3) of his career, threw seven fewer interceptions than the previous season, and posted a single-season-best 2.3 percent interception rate.

Prior to Chicago, Gase served on the Broncos staff in a variety of roles, including offensive coordinator (2013-14), quarterbacks coach (2011-12) and wide receivers coach (2009-10) as Denver won four AFC West titles, three playoff games and an AFC Championship.

In two seasons as the offensive coordinator (2013-14), Gase oversaw a record-setting offense that produced over 430 yards per game, including 315.8 yards per game passing and 34 points per game, all the best in the league over that span. In 2013, they set NFL single-season records for most points scored (606) and most passing yards (5,444), while five different players (three wide receivers, a tight end and a running back) all scored 10+ touchdowns.

Additionally, Manning established single-season NFL records in passing yards (5,477) and passing touchdowns (55), earning NFL Most Valuable Player honors for his efforts. In three seasons under Gase (2012-14), Manning posted a 131-to-35 touchdown to interception ratio, completing 67.7% of his passes for a passer rating of 107.8.



ADAM GASE

In his first season as the team's quarterbacks coach (2011), Gase oversaw quarterbacks Kyle Orton and Tim Tebow, as the latter helped guide the team to a division title and a postseason berth. Under Gase, Tebow ran for 660 yards and six touchdowns, at the time, the ninth-highest rushing total by a quarterback since the merger.

He initially served on Denver's staff as the team's wide receivers coach (2009-10). In those years, he coached a pair of Pro Bowlers, first wide receiver Brandon Marshall (2009), who produced 101 receptions for 1,120 yards and 10 touchdowns, and then wide receiver Brandon Lloyd (2010), who led the league with 1,448 yards on 77 receptions (18.8 average).

Before joining the Broncos staff, Gase spent one season with San Francisco as an offensive assistant under Offensive Coordinator Mike Martz, assisting an offense that saw running back Frank Gore produce over 1,000 yards rushing.

Gase entered the NFL ranks with the Detroit Lions in 2003, serving as scouting/coaching assistant for three seasons under Steve Mariucci before becoming an offensive quality control coach in 2006 and the quarterbacks coach in 2007 under Rod Marinelli. In his season as quarterbacks coach, Jon Kitna posted 4,068 passing yards, the second-highest total of his 14-year career, finishing sixth in the league in passing yards.

Gase began his coaching career as a defensive graduate assistant at LSU in 2000. He spent the following two seasons on the recruiting staff for Head Coach Nick Saban, winning a Southeastern Conference championship in 2001 and helping recruit a group of players that won the BCS National Championship in 2003.

Gase attended Michigan State University from 1996-99 earning a bachelor's degree. He and his wife, Jennifer, have a daughter, McKenzie, and two sons, A.J. and Wyatt.

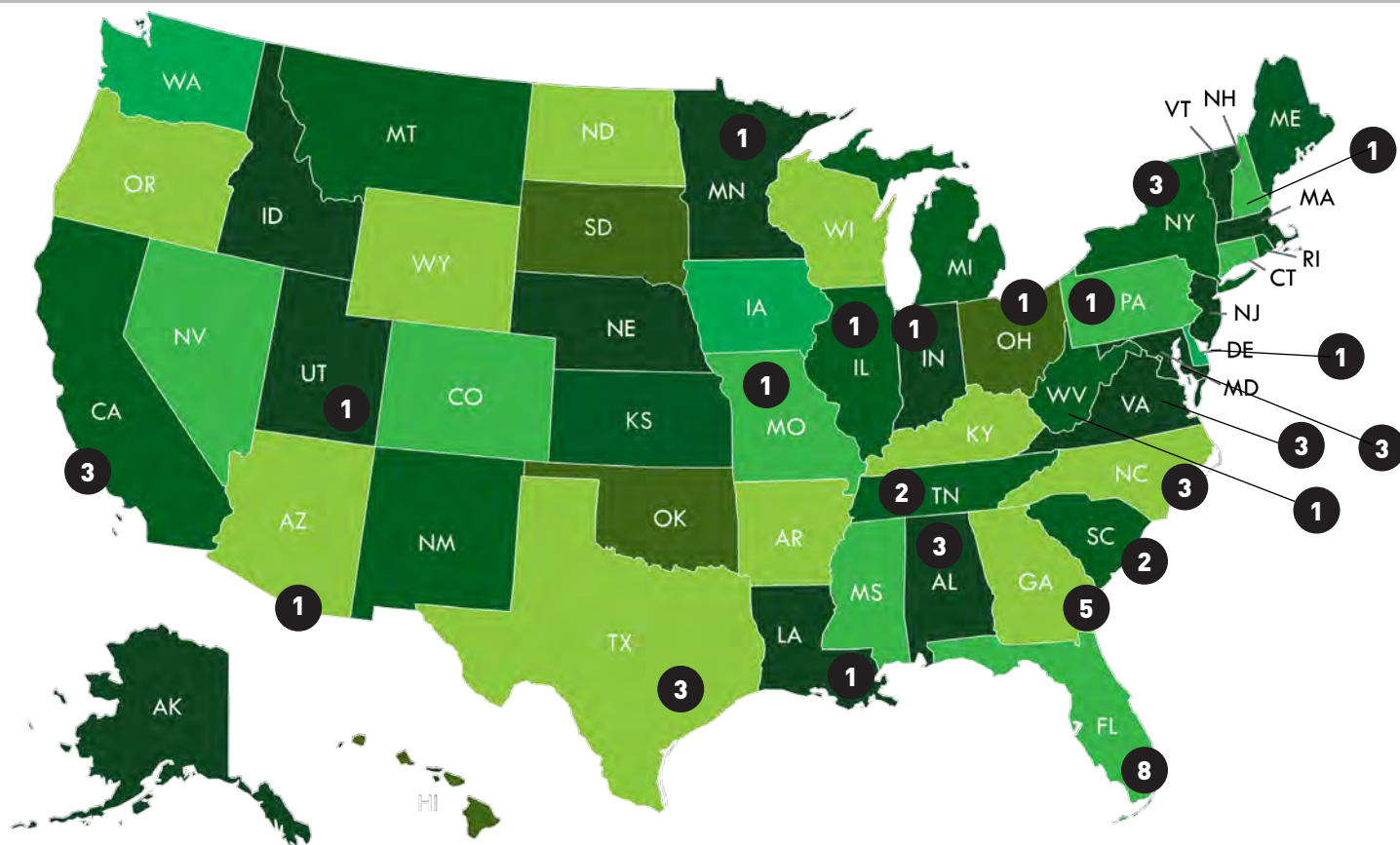
