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The Seahawks open the season at home for only the seventh time in the last 20 seasons, this with a match-up against the Cincinnati Bengals who make their first appearance at CenturyLink Field since 2011. Kickoff is set for 1:05 p.m. (PT). Seattle alternates home and away games for the first 10 weeks of the season.

The Seahawks are 16-27 all-time in Kickoff Weekend games and Pete Carroll is 7-6 as a head coach, with a 4-5 Kickoff Weekend record with Seattle.

This will be the 20th meeting between the two teams with Cincinnati leading the series, 10-9. The Bengals have won three of the last four meetings dating back to 2003, including the last two, with the most recent being a 27-24 overtime victory on October 11, 2015 in Cincinnati.

## **2018 RECAP**

#### **27 OR MORE POINTS SCORED**

Seattle ranked sixth in the NFL in scoring with 26.8 points per game but scored 27 or more points in nine of its last 12 contests (28.6 ppg) and scored 30 or more points five times last year.

In 2017, the Seahawks scored 27 or more points four times and 30 or more points three times.

Over the last half of the season, the Seahawks ranked third in the league averaging 30.0 points per game.

Since 2010, Seattle is 58-13 when winning the turnover battle. It led the NFL in 2013 with 39 takeaways and a +20 differential, ranked fourth in the league in 2014 at +10 and finished 2015 tied for fifth at +7.

Seattle's NFL-record streak of not losing by more than 10 points in 85 regular season games (95 games including playoffs) ended at Green Bay (12/11/16).

Also, the Seahawks largest defeat from Week 9 (11/6/11) of 2011 through Week 2 of 2015 was a 10-point loss at Green Bay (9/20/15), a span of 57 games (65 including playoffs).

#### **139 CONSECUTIVE SELL OUTS**

Since the Seahawks trip to Super Bowl XL, NFC West crowns from 2004-07, 2010, 2013-14 and 2016, a Super Bowl XLVIII championship and Super Bowl XLIX appearance, Seattle's fans do not want to miss out on seeing their team in action. Since 2003, all but one game has sold out, giving the team 139 consecutive sell outs including Week 1 of the 2019 season, including playoffs.

Fans set the CenturyLink Field attendance record (69,190) vs. Philadelphia (11/20/16).

For the seventh-consecutive year, Seattle posted at least a 97% season ticket renewal rate while selling all 61,000 available season tickets.

Training Camp presented by Safeway practices open to the public also sold out. In all, more than 30,000 fans attended the team's 13 open camp sessions.

#### 80-39-1 RECORD IN LAST 120 GAMES

Seattle has compiled an 80-39-1 record since the final half of the 2011 regular season and in those 39 losses, the average margin of victory for the opponent has been 6.3 points (247 points).

#### 28-19-1 ROAD RECORD SINCE 2013

Seattle is 28-19-1 in its last 48 road games dating back to 2013 and posted an 11-6 record in its last 17 10 a.m. (PT) kickoff starts.

#### 2,246 ROSTER TRANSACTIONS SINCE 2010

Since forming their relationship in 2010, General Manager John Schneider and Pete Carroll have put together the NFL's most competitive, deep and talented roster over the last 10 seasons.

Of the 53 players on Seattle's 2019 active roster, 32 are Seattle draft choices, three have been acquired via trade, 18 have been signed as free agents, and 11 of the 53 originally entered the league as undrafted rookie free agents.

#### **95-41 HOME RECORD SINCE 2002**

One thing that has been a constant from the early days of the Kingdome through the championship years of CenturyLink Field is that the 12s have given that extra edge to the Seahawks when playing in the Puget Sound.

Seattle has the NFC's best home winning percentage since moving to the NFC in 2002 with a 95-41 record, and is one of two teams with 90-plus wins during that span.

After missing 12 games in 2017 with a leg injury, third-year running back Chris Carson bounced back last season to start all 14 games played and rush for 1,151 yards (5th NFL), becoming Seattle's first 1,000-yard rusher since 2014 (Marshawn Lynch) and only the **sixth player in franchise history to accomplish that feat**.
