

GAMEDAY WINDOW OVERVIEW

- The default window status is determined by the weather forecast each week
- The status will be communicated to the suite administrator in the Gameday Newsletter, sent the week of the game
- To request a change to your windows, please contact Zach Tomlinson ahead of the game at Zach.Tomlinson@Bengals.nfl.net or ask your Bengals Suites and Hospitality team member on gameday.
- **Please do NOT attempt to maneuver the window on your own - this must be done by our maintenance team!**





WINDOWS OPEN

[RECOMMENDED]

DEFAULT UNLESS WEATHER IS SEVERE

PROS

- Full stadium atmosphere experience
- Clear sightlines
- HVAC vent above window still helps with comfort

CONS

- Most weather exposure

MIDDLE PANEL OPEN

ONE PANEL OPEN, TWO SIDE PANELS CLOSED

PROS

- Balances atmosphere with exposure to inclement weather

CONS

- Moderate sound muffling
- Window frames visible in sightlines





SIDE FLAP OPEN

DEFAULT FOR EXTREMELY COLD GAMES

PROS

- Allows better air circulation than if all windows were closed
- The panel can be rotated as desired

CONS

- Seat(s) in front of the flap exposed to draft
- This setting has the most window frames visible in sightlines

CLOSED

RARELY DEFAULT, AVAILABLE UPON REQUEST

PROS

- Completely sheltered from weather

CONS

- Insulates from stadium noise and atmosphere
- Window frames visible in sightlines
- Suite can feel stuffy without air flow
