**PACKERS AND BENGALS SQUARE OFF ON SUNDAY**  
The Green Bay Packers travel to Ohio to take on the Cincinnati Bengals in the first of four road contests in five weeks.

- ▶ It will be the sixth visit for Green Bay to Cincinnati and the first since 2013.
- ▶ Each of the last three games at the Bengals have been decided by seven points or less.
- ▶ The Packers are looking for their first victory in Cincinnati since 1998.
- ▶ The two teams last met in 2017, a 27-24 overtime victory by Green Bay at Lambeau Field in Week 3.
- ▶ This will be the 14th matchup between the two teams and the seventh time they will play in October.
- ▶ The Packers have started the season with a 3-1 record, marking the third consecutive season Green Bay has opened the season with at least three wins in its first four games (3-1, 4-0, 3-1). Since 2019, the Packers have a combined record of 10-2 in the first four games of the season, a .833 winning percentage that is tied for the **best in the NFL** (Buffalo and Kansas City) over that span (stathead.com).
- ▶ Sunday will be the first time the Packers have played at 12 p.m. CT this season, the first of three consecutive early-Sunday slots for Green Bay. The Packers are 11-1 under Head Coach **Matt LaFleur** in games played at 12 p.m. CT, a .917 winning percentage that ranks **No. 1 in the NFL** since 2019.

## AGAINST THE AFC

- ▶ The Packers faced their first AFC opponent of the season last week, beating the Pittsburgh Steelers, 27-17, at home. Dating back to 2020, Green Bay is 4-1 against AFC opponents, an .800 winning percentage that is **tied for No. 1 in the NFL** (Buffalo and Tampa Bay).
- ▶ Under Head Coach **Matt LaFleur**, Green Bay is 7-2 against AFC opponents, a .778 winning percentage that is **tied for No. 1 in the NFL** (New Orleans) from 2019-21 (stathead.com).
- ▶ The Packers have scored over 30 points in five of their last eight games against AFC teams.
- ▶ Green Bay ranks **No. 7 in the NFL** and **No. 2 in the NFC** in point differential (plus-73) against AFC opponents since 2019.
- ▶ QB **Aaron Rodgers** has registered a passer rating of 100-plus in eight of the last 11 games he has played against AFC teams, including in four of his last five games (128.1, 110.7, 108.1, 132.4, 95.6).
- ▶ In his last 11 games against the AFC, Rodgers has thrown 29 TDs and three interceptions, while recording five 300-yard games (including two 400-yard games). The Packers are 9-2 in Rodgers' last 11 starts against AFC opponents.
- ▶ Over the last 13 games he has played against AFC teams, WR **Davante Adams** has tallied 14 receiving TDs.
- ▶ In 13 games played versus AFC opponents, RB **Aaron Jones** has recorded nine TDs (six rushing and three receiving) and averaged 5.0 yards per carry and 11.9 yards per reception.

## WITH THE CALL

FOX Sports, now in its 28th season as an NFL network television partner, will broadcast the game.



- ▶ Play-by-play man **Kenny Albert** joins analyst **Jonathan Vilma** and sideline reporter **Lindsay Czarniak**.
- ▶ DIRECTV subscribers can watch the game with NFL Network Ticket on Channel 710.
- ▶ Sports USA Radio will be broadcasting to a national audience with **Josh Appel** (play-by-play) and **Mark Carrier** (analyst) on the call.
- ▶ Milwaukee's WTMJ (620 AM), airing Green Bay games since November 1929, heads up the Packers Radio Network that is made up of 49 stations in four states. For a full listing of radio affiliates, go to [www.packers.com](http://www.packers.com).
- ▶ **Wayne Larrivee** (play-by-play) and two-time Packers Pro Bowler **Larry McCarren** (analyst) call the action. McCarren first joined the team's broadcasts in 1995 and enters his 26th season calling Packers games. After originally being paired together in 1999, McCarren and Larrivee enter their 23rd season of broadcasts together. They surpassed Jim Irwin and Max McGee for the most regular-season and postseason games broadcast for the Packers with 313 at the 2018 season opener against Chicago. Both McCarren and Larrivee are members of the Wisconsin Broadcasters Hall of Fame.
- ▶ The broadcast is also available on Sirius Satellite Radio (WTMJ feed).

## HEAD COACH MATT LAFLEUR

### LAFLEUR LEADS THE PACK

Head Coach **Matt LaFleur** (la-flew-er) has led the Packers to back-to-back NFC North titles.

- ▶ According to the Elias Sports Bureau, LaFleur was the **sixth head coach since 1970** to lead their team to the conference championship game in both of his first two seasons as a head coach, joining Jim Harbaugh (2011-12), Rex Ryan (2009-10), Barry Switzer (1994-95), George Seifert (1989-90) and Don McCafferty (1970-71).
- ▶ LaFleur is just the **second NFL head coach** since the league went to a divisional format in 1967 to win 13-plus games and a division title in both of his first two seasons (2019-20), joining Seifert (1989-90).
- ▶ LaFleur (26-6) posted the **most regular-season wins by a Packer head coach in his first two seasons** (Mike Sherman and Mike McCarthy, 21 each).
- ▶ LaFleur (26) posted the **second-most wins in NFL history by a coach in his first two seasons** behind only Seifert (28 in 1989-90).
- ▶ LaFleur guided the Packers to 26 wins in 2019-20 after the Packers won 13 games in 2017-18. That was the **biggest two-season win improvement** by a head coach in franchise history from the two seasons prior to him taking over, eclipsing the previous mark held by Vince Lombardi (15 victories in 1959-60 after the Packers won four games in 1957-58).
- ▶ LaFleur led the biggest one-year win improvement in franchise history in 2019:

- ▶ LaFleur is now 12-1 in the NFC North (.923) after a victory over Detroit in Week 2.
- ▶ LaFleur's winning percentage of .917 (11-1) against division opponents in 2019-20 **tied for the second best** by a coach in his first two seasons as head coach, dating back to 1970 (Mike Tomlin, 11-1, .917 in 2007-08 / Steve Mariucci, 15-1, .938 in 1997-98).
- ▶ LaFleur has not lost back-to-back games as a head coach.
- ▶ Dating back to 2019 (including playoffs), LaFleur has led the Packers to a 15-4 record (.789) in games decided by single digits.
- ▶ Dating back to 2019, the Packers have the **best regular-season record in the NFL**:

- ▶ Dating back to 2019, Green Bay ranks in the **top 10 in the NFL** in the regular season in point differential (plus-198, No. 5), points per game (27.2, No. 6) and points allowed (21.7, No. 8).

- ▶ Green Bay has forced two turnovers in each of its last three games. Under LaFleur, the Packers are 14-1 (.933) when posting two-plus takeaways in a game and have a plus-28 turnover margin (37/9) in those 15 contests.
- ▶ The Packers are 22-0 under LaFleur when they win the takeaway battle. In those 22 wins, Green Bay has turned the ball over a total of five times and created 43 turnovers for a turnover differential of plus-38. The Packers have scored 694 points in those 22 wins (31.5 ppg) while allowing 420 points (19.1 ppg), and have scored 30-plus points in 15 of those 22 games.
- ▶ Under LaFleur, Green Bay is 26-1 when forcing at least one turnover, a .963 winning percentage that ranks **No. 1 in the NFL** since 2019.
- ▶ Under LaFleur, the Packers had six players register 30-plus receptions in 2019-20, marking the **first time in franchise history** that Green Bay had six players with 30-plus catches in back-to-back seasons.
- ▶ LaFleur tied for the **fifth-best record by a head coach** in his first 36 games (Elias Sports Bureau):

- ▶ LaFleur led Green Bay to a 20-5 record in his first 25 regular-season games, which **tied for No. 4 in NFL history** for the most wins by a head coach in his first 25 regular-season games (Elias Sports Bureau).
- ▶ LaFleur recorded the **best home winning percentage by a Packers head coach in his first two seasons** since 1921:

- ▶ 2019-20 was the first time Green Bay won seven-plus games in back-to-back seasons at Lambeau Field since doing it in three straight seasons from 2010-12.
- ▶ LaFleur (13-3) finished with the **most NFL wins by a Packer head coach in their first season**:

- ▶ LaFleur (13-3) **tied for the third-most wins** by an NFL head coach in their first season (Jim Caldwell, IND, 2009, 14-2 / George Seifert, SF, 1989, 14-2 / Jim Harbaugh, SF, 2011, 13-3 / Steve Mariucci, SF, 1997, 13-3).
- ▶ LaFleur joined Jim Caldwell and Mariucci as the only head coaches with 13-plus wins to go undefeated in their division in their first season.
- ▶ LaFleur became the first Packer head coach to start both of his first two seasons 3-0 (2019-20).



*Two years after he co-founded the Packers with Curly Lambeau, George Calhoun began writing a piece called The Dope Sheet, which served as the official press release from 1921-24.*

## NOTES FROM WEEK 4 VS. PITTSBURGH

- ▶ The Packers improved to 3-1 on the season with a 27-17 victory over the Pittsburgh Steelers last Sunday at Lambeau Field. It marked Green Bay's first regular-season win over the Steelers since Dec. 24, 1995 (also at Lambeau Field).
- ▶ With the win, Green Bay is now 16-2 (.889) under Head Coach **Matt LaFleur** in the regular season at Lambeau Field, the top winning percentage in the league at home since 2019.

- ▶ Green Bay registered a season-high 131 rushing yards on 33 carries (4.0 avg.).
- ▶ The Packers finished with a turnover differential of plus-1, improving to 22-0 under LaFleur when winning the turnover battle (4-1 when even and 3-6 when minus). Green Bay's 22 games with a positive turnover differential since 2019 rank **No. 1 in the NFL** over that span (Pittsburgh, 21 / Seattle, 20).
- ▶ Green Bay is **tied for No. 8 in the NFL** this season in turnover differential (plus-2). Since 2019, the Packers rank **No. 3 in the NFL** in turnover differential:

- ▶ Week 4 marked the third game this season the Packers have won the turnover differential, **tied for No. 2 in the NFL**:

- ▶ Through four weeks in the NFL, teams that win the turnover differential are 37-11 (.771), via stathead.com.
- ▶ Green Bay converted on 9 of 15 third downs, a season-high 60.0 percent. The Packers rank **No. 7 in the NFL** in third-down percentage (44.4 pct.) this season.
- ▶ Dating back to last season, the Packers have held their opponents to 17 or fewer points in five consecutive regular-season games at Lambeau Field, the longest current home streak in the league and **tied for the longest home streak since 1970**:

- ▶ Green Bay has held two of four opponents to 17 points this season (Weeks 2 and 4) and is **tied for No. 3** in games allowing 17 or fewer points. Carolina and Denver lead the league with three games each (stathead.com).

- ▶ The Packers defense gave up just 258 yards on 58 plays (4.9 avg.) to the Steelers while forcing two turnovers.
- ▶ Green Bay has multiple takeaways in each of the last three games (Weeks 2-4), its longest streak since a four-game streak in 2017 (Weeks 4-7).
- ▶ Green Bay ranks in the top 10 in the NFL in total yards allowed/game:

- ▶ The Packers also rank in the **top 10 in the league** in yards per play allowed (5.21, **No. 8**), pass yards per game allowed (209.5, **No. 8**) and pass yards per play allowed (6.12, **No. 9**).
- ▶ Green Bay has allowed the second-fewest yards on defense through the first four games that it has in the last 10 seasons:

- ▶ WR **Davante Adams** has 31 catches on the season, the **second most in team history** by a player in the first four games of a season behind only WR Jordy Nelson (33 in 2014).
- ▶ Adams **leads the NFL** in receptions and ranks **No. 5** in receiving yards this season:

- ▶ WR **Randall Cobb** had two receiving TDs, his first game with multiple receiving TDs since he posted three vs. Kansas City on Sept. 28, 2015.
- ▶ Rodgers has now thrown 41 TD passes to Cobb, putting them into a **tie for the fourth-most productive TD combination in team history** (41 from Brett Favre to Sterling Sharpe, 41 from Rodgers to James Jones).
- ▶ Cobb has nine receptions on the season, including eight that have picked up first downs for an 88.9 percentage that **leads the NFL this season** (min. two rec. per team game, Stats Pass).
- ▶ CB **Eric Stokes** posted his first career interception when he picked off QB Ben Roethlisberger in the fourth quarter. Stokes is **tied for No. 2 in the NFL** with six passes defensed.
- ▶ LB **Preston Smith** played in his 100th game and joins New Orleans LB Demario Davis (148) as the only NFL linebackers to have an active streak of at least 70 consecutive games played.
- ▶ DL **Kingsley Keke's** forced fumble on his second-quarter sack of Roethlisberger was the second forced fumble of his career.

## MORE FROM WEEK 4 VS. PITTSBURGH

- ▶ With two TD passes, QB **Aaron Rodgers** brought his career passing-TD total to 420, tying QB Dan Marino for **No. 6 in NFL history**:

- ▶ Rodgers also ran for a TD, marking the 18th time he has posted two-plus passing TDs and at least one rushing TD in the same game, the second most all-time (Elias Sports Bureau):

- ▶ With two field goals (26, 29) made in Week 4, K **Mason Crosby** brought his streak of consecutive FGs made to 24, which set a new franchise record (Crosby, 23, 2010-11).
- ▶ Crosby is **one of five NFL players** to not miss a field goal this season (min. four att.).
- ▶ P **Corey Bojorquez** recorded three punts for 138 yards (46.0 avg., 41.3 net avg.), including landing one punt at the PIT 4-yard line and another he launched 57 yards from the end zone that resulted in a fair catch by the Steelers at the PIT 37-yard line.
- ▶ Bojorquez is **tied for No. 8 in the NFL** in net punting average (42.9 avg.).

## ON THE ROAD

Green Bay has performed well on the road over the last few years. So far this season, the Packers are 1-1 (.500).

- ▶ Green Bay went 6-2 in each of the first two seasons (2019-20) under Head Coach **Matt LaFleur**, marking the **first time in franchise history** that the Packers won six-plus road games in back-to-back seasons.
- ▶ The 6-2 (.750) road records by Green Bay in 2019-20 marked just the **fourth and fifth times since 1978** (7-1 in 2011 / 6-2 in 2007 and 2004), when the NFL went to a 16-game schedule, that Green Bay won six-plus road games in the regular season (pro-football-reference.com).
- ▶ The Packers were **one of five NFL teams** (Baltimore, Buffalo, Kansas City, New Orleans) to win at least six road games in 2019 and in 2020.
- ▶ Green Bay has scored 30-plus points in eight of the last 10 road contests, including in one of two road games this season.
- ▶ In 2019-20, the Packers had a regular-season road winning streak of five, the team's longest since 2011 and tied for the third longest since the NFL/AFL merger.

- ▶ QB **Aaron Rodgers** has a career passer rating of 103.9 on the road, ranking **No. 3 among active players** (min. 1500 pass att.):

- ▶ Green Bay was **tied for No. 2 in the NFL** with a 6-2 record on the road in 2020.
- ▶ The Packers finished **No. 2 in the NFL** in points per game scored on the road last season (32.0).
- ▶ Green Bay's 6-2 road mark in 2019 was **tied for No. 6 in the NFL**.
- ▶ Since 2000, Green Bay is **one of only six NFL teams** to have a regular-season road record above .500:

**MATT LaFLEUR...**In his third season as the Packers' 15th head coach.

- ▶ In his 13th season in the NFL, having previously served as an offensive coordinator for two seasons (Los Angeles Rams, 2017; Tennessee Titans, 2018), a quarterbacks coach for six seasons (Washington Football Team, 2010-13; Atlanta Falcons, 2015-16), and an offensive assistant for two seasons (Houston Texans, 2008-09).
- ▶ In his first two seasons leading the Packers, has authored one of the greatest starts to a head-coaching career in NFL history. For the second consecutive season in 2020, led Green Bay to a 13-3 record and captured the NFC North crown while also earning the No. 1 seed in the NFC for the first time since 2011. It was just the second time in team history that the Packers had won 13-plus games in back-to-back seasons (13-3 in 1996 and 1997).
- ▶ According to the Elias Sports Bureau, was the sixth head coach since 1970 to lead his team to the conference championship game in both of his first two seasons as a head coach, joining Jim Harbaugh (2011-12), Rex Ryan (2009-10), Barry Switzer (1994-95), George Seifert (1989-90) and Don McCafferty (1970-71).
- ▶ Became just the second NFL head coach since the league went to a divisional format in 1967 to win 13-plus games and a division title in both of his first two seasons, joining Seifert (1989-90).
- ▶ In his first season leading the Packers in 2019, became the first coach in club history to lead the team to the playoffs in his debut season. Also led the largest one-year win improvement in team history (plus-seven wins).

**ZAC TAYLOR...**In his third season as the Bengals' 10th head coach.

- ▶ In 2020, Taylor helped QB Joe Burrow to one of the most productive starts to a career by a QB in NFL history before a knee injury ended the rookie's season after 10 games. Burrow's 264 completions were the most ever by an NFL QB through their first 10 career games.
- ▶ Came to Cincinnati after two seasons (2017-18) with the L.A. Rams, where he served as assistant wide receivers coach in 2017 and quarterbacks coach in '18. In 2018, he helped guide Rams QB Jared Goff to career highs in every major passing category. Los Angeles won the NFC West with a 13-3 regular-season record and advanced to Super Bowl LIII against the New England Patriots.

## THE PACKERS-BENGALS SERIES

- ▶ The Bengals have won three of the last four regular-season meetings (2005, 2009 and 2013), with the Packers winning most recently in 2017. Prior to 2005 Green Bay owned a three-game winning streak in the series (24-23 in 1992 and 24-10 in 1995, both in Green Bay, and 13-6 in 1998 at Cincinnati).
- ▶ Perhaps the most memorable game in the series came in 1992 when Brett Favre, summoned to replace an injured Don Majkowski at quarterback in the first quarter, proceeded to direct the Packers to an electrifying, 24-23 come-from-behind victory, forged when he hit wide receiver Kitrick Taylor for a 35-yard TD pass with only 13 seconds remaining in the game.
- ▶ The series launched at Lambeau Field in 1971, when the legendary Paul Brown was head coach of the Bengals, a team he had founded three years earlier as a member of the then American Football League. The Packers posted a 20-17 victory in their first meeting, with a Lou Michaels field goal providing the victory margin.

### LAST MEETING, REGULAR SEASON

- Sept. 24, 2017, Lambeau Field, Packers won, 27-24, OT
- ▶ Green Bay trailed, 21-7, at halftime, but were led to a second-half comeback by QB Aaron Rodgers, who threw for 313 yards and three TDs.
  - ▶ The Packers tied the game at 24 when Rodgers found WR Jordy Nelson for his second TD of the game, a 3 yard pass with 17 seconds remaining in the game.
  - ▶ In overtime, following a three-and-out by Cincinnati, Rodgers hit WR Geronimo Allison for a gain of 72 yards, which set up a game-winning 27-yard FG by K Mason Crosby to give Green Bay its first victory over Cincinnati since 1998.

**A LOOK AT THE SCHEDULE**

The Green Bay Packers' 2021 NFL schedule features 17 regular-season games and three preseason games. It is highlighted by five prime-time contests (subject to flexible scheduling) on the original schedule for the eighth straight year (2014-21).

- ▶ Entering 2021, Green Bay had the fourth-highest strength of schedule (.542, 147-124-1) and leads the league with the most games (10) against 2020 playoff teams. The Packers face 10 teams who had a .500-or-better record in 2020, tied for the third most in the league.
- ▶ The Packers opened the season at the New Orleans Saints, marking the third straight year and the seventh time in the last nine seasons that Green Bay had started the season on the road.
- ▶ Week 2 brought a division opponent at home for the fourth consecutive season, and for the second straight year it was the Detroit Lions. The game was on *Monday Night Football* and was the first of three home prime-time games against division opponents.
- ▶ The Packers went back on the road in Week 3 as they traveled to face the San Francisco 49ers on a Sunday night, marking the fourth consecutive season Green Bay faced the 49ers in a prime-time contest and the third consecutive year on the road.

- ▶ Over the next two weeks, Green Bay will play the first of two back-to-backs against the AFC North. The Packers welcomed the Pittsburgh Steelers to Lambeau Field in Week 4 and will travel to Cincinnati to take on the Bengals in Week 5. The Cincinnati game will be the first of four road contests in five weeks for the Packers.
- ▶ Week 6 brings a return to division play as Green Bay goes to Chicago and faces off with the Bears.
- ▶ The Packers then return to Lambeau for a Week 7 contest against the Washington Football Team before back-to-back road trips.
- ▶ The Packers will visit the Arizona Cardinals on a Thursday night in Week 8 to finish an October slate that will see them play five games for the first time since 2010, and then a trip to Kansas City to play the Chiefs in Week 9.
- ▶ Green Bay plays six of its final eight regular-season games against the NFC, starting with the Seattle Seahawks in Week 10 at home.
- ▶ After a trip to play the Minnesota Vikings in Week 11, Green Bay finishes the regular season with four of its last six games at home for the second straight year and the fourth time since 1940 (1969, 1977).
- ▶ Green Bay hosts the Los Angeles Rams before a Week 13 bye, marking the seventh straight season the Packers will play at home heading into their bye week. It is the latest bye ever for Green Bay, and it is the fourth time since 1990 that the Packers have had a bye in Week 10 or later (Week 11 in 2019, Week 10 in 2012 and 2010). It will be the first time since 2017 that Green Bay plays at home heading into the bye and coming out of the bye.
- ▶ The matchup versus Chicago on a Sunday night in Week 14 marks the 16th consecutive regular season that the Packers and Bears have squared off in a prime-time game.
- ▶ In Weeks 15-16, Green Bay will finish off its slate against the AFC North with a trip to face the Baltimore Ravens and then a home game on Christmas Day against the Cleveland Browns. It is just the third time the Packers will play on Christmas, having hosted the Bears in 2005 and 2011.
- ▶ Green Bay will end the regular season with back-to-back NFC North games for the fourth time in the last six seasons.
- ▶ The Packers' last regular-season home game is slated for a Sunday night versus the Vikings in Week 17.
- ▶ For the fourth time in the last six years, Green Bay will end the regular season in Detroit. The game at the Lions is scheduled for Sunday, but the league schedule does not list Saturday games or a Sunday night game in Week 18, and three games with playoff implications will be moved to those time slots no later than six days prior to January 9.

## CONSECUTIVE-SELLOUT STREAK

Due to health and safety concerns, the Packers made the decision to first not have fans at home games and then to sell a limited number tickets to a few home games in 2020 due to the pandemic, which put a pause to the franchise's sellout streak. The Packers are happy to welcome back full crowds this season and after Week 4 against Pittsburgh, the sellout streak moved to 352 regular-season games (not including replacement games).

- ▶ The league's longest-tenured stadium, Lambeau Field is hosting its 65th season of football in 2021. For the victory over Seattle in the Divisional round of the 2019 playoffs, 78,998 Packers fans filled Lambeau Field for the second-highest paid attendance in stadium history (79,704 in the Divisional round of the 2014 playoffs versus Dallas).
- ▶ Across American professional sports, only Boston's Fenway Park (1912) and Chicago's Wrigley Field (1914) have longer tenures.

## BREAKING DOWN THE ROSTER

The Packers enter Week 5 with a 51-man roster that is composed of 23 offensive players, 25 defensive players and three specialists.

- ▶ Of the 51 players on Green Bay's roster, 30 of them (58.8 percent) were draft picks of the Packers. Green Bay has eight players that were drafted in the first round, including seven that were selected by the Packers.
- ▶ Green Bay has 11 players on the roster that began their careers as undrafted free agents.
- ▶ 41.1 percent of the players (21 of 51) on Green Bay's roster entered the league as a sixth-round or seventh-round pick or as an undrafted player.
- ▶ Of the 51 players on the roster, 45 of them (88.2 percent) are 28 years old or younger (as of Oct 5) and 24 players (47.0 percent) are 24 years old or younger.
- ▶ Of the 51 players on the roster, 11 of them (21.5 percent) played collegiately outside of the "Power Five" conferences (ACC, Big 10, Big 12, Pac-12 and SEC).
- ▶ Over 26 percent of the players (15 of 51, 29.4 percent) attended high school in either California (9 players) or Texas (6 players). In total, Green Bay's roster is composed of players from 24 different states and two different countries (United States and Canada).

GREEN BAY, Wis. (AP) — RB Aaron Jones caught three of Aaron Rodgers' four TD passes and rushed for a fourth score, and the Packers had a welcome return to normal, dominating the second half in a 35-17 win over the division rival Lions on Monday night. Jones became the first Packers running back to catch three touchdown passes in a game since Andy Uram against the Chicago Cardinals in 1942. He had 17 carries for 67 yards and six catches for 48 yards. Rodgers went 22 of 27 for 255 yards and surpassed John Elway for 10th all-time in passing yards with 51,633. Rodgers has followed up each of the Packers' last five regular-season losses by throwing four touchdown passes and no interceptions in his next game. Detroit's Jared Goff completed 13 of his first 14 passes but struggled the rest of the way as the Lions (0-2) blew a 17-14 halftime lead. Goff finished 26 of 36 for 246 yards. He connected on touchdown passes to Quintez Cephus and T.J. Hockenson but also threw an interception and lost a fumble. The Packers faced third-and-12 on their opening series of the second half when Rodgers threw a 50-yard completion to Davante Adams, who ended the night with eight catches for 121 yards. Rodgers capped that drive with a 22-yard touchdown pass to Robert Tonyan. Detroit's next series ended when Goff threw an incompletion on fourth-and-1 from the Green Bay 25. Rodgers threw an 11-yard touchdown pass to Jones to extend the Packers' lead to 28-17. Green Bay's Krys Barnes recovered Goff's fumble at the Detroit 23 on the Lions' next snap. Jones scored on a 1-yard run and that was that.

GREEN BAY, Wis. (AP) — Randall Cobb demonstrated why Aaron Rodgers wanted the veteran receiver back in Green Bay. Rodgers connected with Cobb for two touchdowns and ran for another score as the Packers won their third straight, 27-17 over the Pittsburgh Steelers on Sunday. Cobb caught a 23-yard touchdown pass in the second quarter to put the Packers (3-1) ahead for good and scored again on a 1-yard reception that made it 27-10 in the third period. That short throw was the 420th TD pass of Rodgers' career, tying Dan Marino for sixth all-time. Through the first three games, Cobb had four catches for 58 yards. He caught five passes for 69 yards Sunday. Rodgers and Cobb connected on two third-down completions that set up Green Bay's touchdown. Cobb's go-ahead score also came on third down. Rodgers went 20 of 36 for 248 yards and scored the Packers' first points on a 4-yard rush in his first home start against the Steelers, the only team he hadn't faced at Lambeau Field. After falling behind 7-0, Green Bay scored 27 of the next 30 points to seize control. It was the first time Rodgers and Ben Roethlisberger had faced off as starting quarterbacks since Green Bay edged Pittsburgh 31-25 in the Super Bowl on Feb. 6, 2011.
