

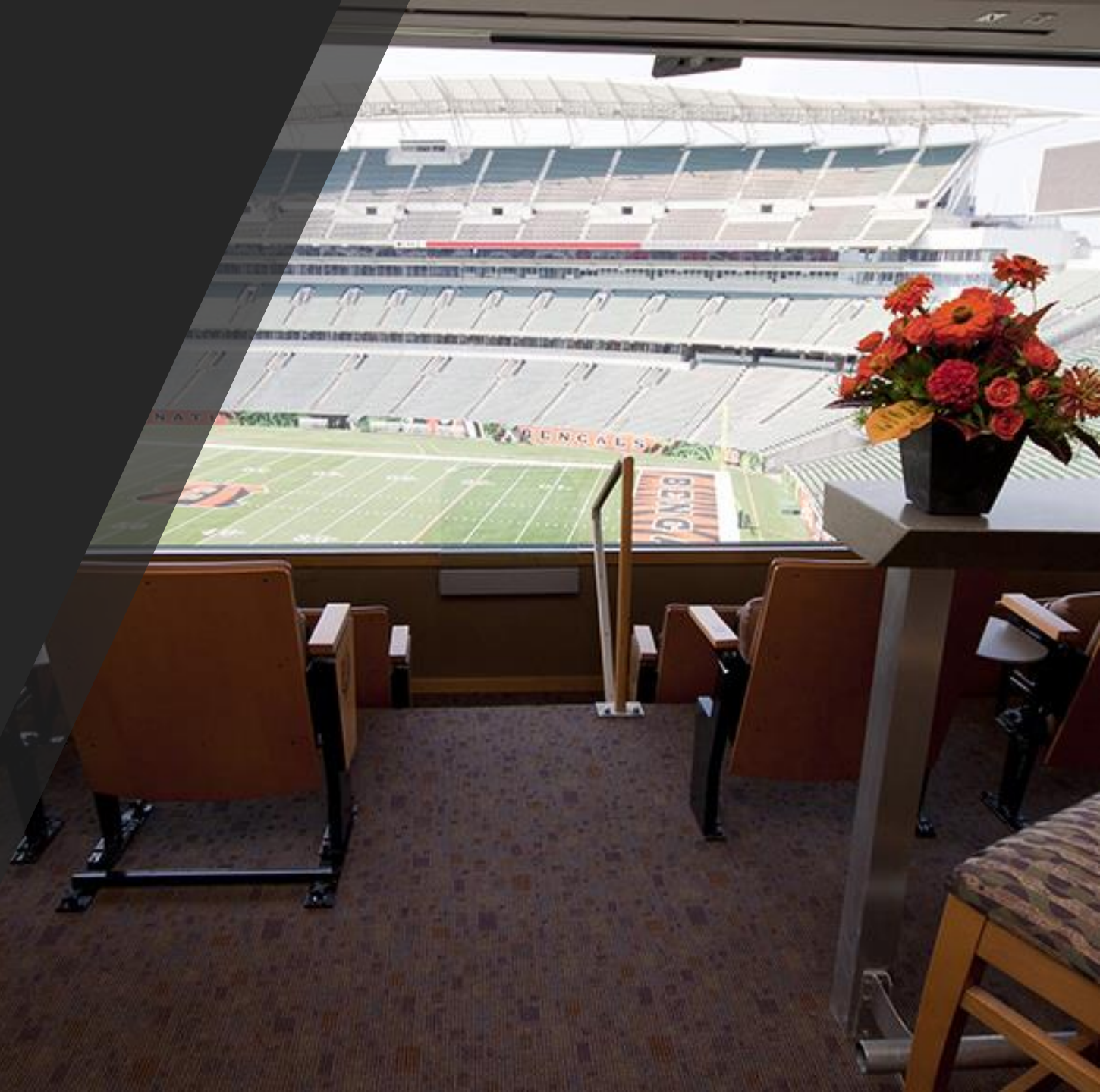
# Game Day Window Options

---



# GAME DAY WINDOWS

- The default status of the windows will be determined by the weather forecast each week
- The status will be communicated to the suite administrator in the Gameday Newsletter, sent the week of the game
- To request a change to your windows please contact Zach Tomlinson ahead of the game at [Zach.Tomlinson@Bengals.nfl.net](mailto:Zach.Tomlinson@Bengals.nfl.net) or ask your Bengals Suites and Hospitality team member on gameday.
- Do NOT attempt to maneuver the window on your own- it must be done by our maintenance team



# WINDOWS OPEN [RECOMMENDED]

This will almost always be the default setting, unless the weather is severe

## Pros

- Full feel for atmosphere & unmuffled sound
- No window frames blocking sightlines
- HVAC vent above window counters external temperature

## Cons

- Most exposed to weather



# MIDDLE PANEL OPEN

One of the three panels is tucked away, leaving panels on the sides

## Pros

- Hybrid of open & closed
- Compromise of temperature vs atmosphere

## Cons

- Moderate muffling of atmosphere
- Window frames blocking sightlines



# SIDE FLAP

Small flap on the side is unlocked, rotated on hinges.

This will be the default setting if the temperature is very cold.

## Pros

- Can be rotated as desired
- Allows air circulation compared to fully closed

## Cons

- Seat in front of flap exposed to draft
- This setting has the most window frames blocking sightlines



# CLOSED

We will never make this the default setting, but it is available to request

## Pros

- Completely sheltered from the weather

## Cons

- Completely muffles stadium atmosphere
- Window frames blocking sightlines
- Suite can feel stuffy without air flow
