TRE'DAVIOUS WHITE re-signed with the Bills in 2025 for his second stint in Buffalo. White entered the NFL as a first round draft pick (27th overall) of the Bills in 2017. He spent his first seven seasons in Buffalo. He signed with the Rams in 2024 and spent the start of the season in Los Angeles before being traded to the Ravens in November.

- Ranked fourth in the league among all defensive players with 17 passes defensed in the 2019 season.
- Has come away with three game-sealing interceptions one at KC and one at Mia., both in 2017 and one against Cincinnati in 2019.

He was the kid who made it out and was the first member of his immediate family to graduate from college.
