

## FIRST-AND-10

STEPHEN GOSNELL joined the Bills in 2025 as an undrafted free agent. Gosnell played collegiately at North Carolina (2020-21) and Virginia Tech (2022-24) and caught 62 career passes for 999 yards and 4 touchdowns.

#### SHOUTOUTS

- In his final season at Virginia Tech in 2024, led team with 506 yards receiving on 28 catches with one TD in 13 games (10 starts).
- Tallied a 9-yard TD catch from Kyron Drones in a win at Stanford (10/5/24).
- Posted career-high 118 yards on 5 catches at Syracuse (11/2/24).
- In 2023, played in all 13 games (12 starts) and registered 22 receptions for 348 yards and 3 touchdowns.
- Scored on a 44-yard reception at Virginia (11/25/23).
- Recorded first collegiate touchdown on a 22-yard catch from Drones in a win at Boston College (11/11/23).
- Tallied a career-high 6 receptions for 75 yards vs. Wake Forest (10/14/23).
- Grabbed 3 passes for 72 yards vs. Purdue (9/9/23).
- Played in 9 games (one start) in first season at Virginia Tech in 2022 and caught 10 passes for 134 yards.
- Recorded 2 receptions for 30 yards during first collegiate start vs. Boston College (9/10/22).
- Saw action in 14 games at North Carolina from 2020-21 and caught 2 passes for 11 yards.
- Registered first career collegiate reception from QB Sam Howell in a victory vs. Duke (10/2/21).
- Played wide receiver, quarterback and safety in high school. Had 99 receptions for 2,134 yards with 32 TDs, while rushing for 2,230 yards and 34 TDs and throwing for 1,684 yards with 19 scores.

#### "MOST DETERMINED GUY THAT I KNOW"

At the lowest point in his football career, Stephen Gosnell created an account on the employment-oriented social networking website, LinkedIn. Gosnell no longer could envision a future in the NFL. He tore the ACL in his left knee during the final game of Virginia Tech's 2023 season in the Military Bowl.

For two weeks, he couldn't dress or feed himself. He had only one year of eligibility remaining and faced a long, arduous recovery. The self-doubt lasted only a few days before Gosnell began to research methods to return within six months.

"I've never seen any player in my playing career or my coaching career handle adversity like Stephen Gosnell," VA Tech receivers coach Fontel Mines said. "He is the most determined guy that I know. He has no choice but to have a great career because he's going to do everything necessary. No job is not important enough for him to accomplish." (Lance Lysowski, Buffalo News)
