



MATT EDWARDS ASSISTANT DEFENSIVE LINE

FIRST-AND-10

MATT EDWARDS was named the Bills assistant defensive line coach in 2024. Edwards joined the Bills after coaching with the Raiders (2022-23) and Titans (2018-21). Prior to beginning his NFL coaching career, Edwards spent 15 seasons coaching in college football (2003-17).

COACHING SHOUTOUTS

2022-23: (Las Vegas Raiders)

- In 2023, the Raiders defense recorded 46 total sacks. The team's 46 sacks tied for the 10th most in a single season in franchise history (since 1982). DE Maxx Crosby led the team with a career-best 14.5 sacks en route to his third Pro Bowl selection.
- In his first season with Las Vegas, Edwards helped guide Crosby to his second Pro Bowl honor after notching 88 tackles, 22 tackles for loss and 12.5 sacks.

2018-21: (Tennessee Titans)

- As assistant special teams coach in 2021, Edwards helped coach K Randy Bullock, who finished ninth in franchise history with 120 points in a season.
- In 2020, he served as the defensive assistant for a unit that ranked seventh in the NFL with 23 takeaways.
- Was the assistant special teams coach from 2018-19. In 2018, the Titans set an NFL record by averaging 32 yards per kickoff return

2014-17: (Tiffin)

- Served as the defensive coordinator for Tiffin from 2014-17.
 Helped Tiffin to consecutive winning seasons in his final two years.
- In 2017, the Dragons led the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference in sacks and tackles for loss.

2013: (Florida Atlantic)

• Served as special teams coordinator and defensive line coach in 2013. The FAU defense finished 11th nationally in total defense, broke four sack records and finished bowl eligible.

COACHING SHOUTOUTS

2011-12: (Miami (Ohio))

 Returned to his alma mater and coached the Redhawks' defensive ends for one season before taking on the responsibility of special teams coordinator and linebackers coach in 2021.

2004-10: (Kent State)

• Spent seven seasons at Kent State, beginning as a graduate assistant (2004-05) before being promoted to defensive line coach (2006-10).

2003: (College of Wooster)

• Started his coaching career in 2003 as the linebackers coach at the College of Wooster.

PLAYING SHOUTOUTS

• Played linebacker and defensive end in college for Miami (OH) and he was named a team captain for his senior season.

PERSONAL

- Earned his bachelor's degree from Miami in sport organization in 2002. Completed his master's degree in sport and recreational management at Kent State.
- A native of Cincinnati, Ohio. Edwards and his wife, Mary, have four sons: Andrew, Luke, Nathan and William.
