ALEC ANDERSON signed with the Bills as an undrafted free agent in 2022 and has since earned playing time as a tackle eligible in the Bills 6-offensive line formations as well as serving as a key reserve along the line. Anderson started 20 games during a four-year stint at UCLA.

- In 2024, played in all 17 regular season games (4 starts) and 3 postseason games. Saw action in 27% of the offensive snaps during the regular season.
- Started and played all 67 snaps at LG at NE (1/5/25).

- Saw action in his first NFL game vs. Arz. (9/8/24) and made first NFL start as a 6th lineman at NYJ (10/14/24).
