**O'CYRUS TORRENCE** was selected by the Bills in the second round (59th overall) in 2023. Torrence played for Louisiana for three seasons (2018-21) before transferring to Florida (2022). Torrence marked the second consecutive year the Bills have drafted a Florida Gator, joining CB Kaiir Elam.

## SHOUTOUTS

- Named to the 2023 PFWA All-Rookie Team.
- During his first year NFL season in 2023, started all 17 regular season games and both of the team's playoff games. Was an integral part of an offensive line that allowed the fewest sacks in the NFL (24).
- Began his collegiate career with Louisiana, playing for the Ragin' Cajuns from 2018-21 and then transferred to Florida for his final college season in 2022.
- Started in 11 games for the Florida Gators in 2022, becoming the first Gators offensive guard to be named a Consensus All-American.
- During his final season with the Ragin' Cajuns in 2021, started and appeared in 11 games. Earned First Team All-Sun Belt Conference honors.
- Played and started in all 11 of Louisiana's games in 2020. Named Second Team All-Sun Belt Conference for his performance.
- Started in 13 of the Ragin' Cajuns 14 games as a true freshman in 2019. Named to the 2019 Football Writers Association of America-Shaun Alexander Freshman All-America Team.

### CYBO

It's easy now to view O'Cyrus Torrence and his 6-5, 330 pound frame as being larger than life--but perhaps by a mother's intuition, Torrence's mom Demetrice, always knew he'd be an imposing figure. According to The Advocate, for as long as can be remembered she referred to O'Cyrus as 'Cyborg.' That nickname quickly gained traction and still sticks with him today, but has been shortened to just 'Cybo'. "Cybo has been with me since I was a kid; my mom used to call me 'Cyborg' from the Teen Titans because I was a big kid," Torrence told The Buffalo News at the Senior Bowl, referring to the popular Cartoon Network series. "It kind of stuck. My brothers cut it to Cybo."

Despite making it to the NFL, Torrence is not someone who is about to forget about the things that are important to him, including: his cat. Arriving in Buffalo the day after being drafted by the Bills, Torrence was sporting a custom suit with photos of his cat, Cece, sewn into the lining. He made it all pretty: put it on the inside of the jacket and inside of the vest. It came out really good."
