TOMMY DOMAN JR. was selected by the Bills in the 7th round in 2026. Doman, who played collegiately at both Michigan and Florida, earned All-SEC honors from Pro Football Focus in 2025.

SHOUTOUTS

- Appeared in all 12 games in his one and only season at Florida in 2025, booting 50 punts for 2,202 yards with a long of 71 yards and 17 downed inside the 20.
- In 2024, served as Michigan's punter, holder and kickoff specialist. Punted 49 times for 2,088 yards (42.6-yard average) with 15 inside the 20. Also kicked off 59 times with 37 touchbacks.
- Was a third-team All-Big Ten selection in 2024.
- Punted 3 times with an average of 47.3 yards and a long of 68 yards at Ohio State (11/30/24) with no return yards allowed.
- Named SEC special teams player of the week with 8 punts for 393 yards with five of 50 yards or longer (a program record since at least 1997) and two punts inside the 10-yard line vs. USC (9/21/24).
- Served as the punter, holder and kickoff specialist for the CFP National Champions in 2023. Posted 53 punts for a 44.3-yard average, including 18 punts downed inside the 20. Registered 68 touchbacks on 99 kickoffs.
- Delivered 6 touchbacks on 7 kickoffs, and punted 5 times for 234 yards (46.8 average) with 2 inside the 20 with no return yards allowed vs. Washington in the CFP National Championship Game (1/8/24).
- Saw action in 4 games in 2022 after redshirting in 2021.
- In 2022, served as a placekicker and made 2 PATs.
- Earned Academic All-Big Ten honors three times from 2022-24 and SEC Fall Academic Honor Roll in 2025.

"YOU GOTTA BE ABLE TO COACH YOURSELF"

In fourth grade, Doman was primarily a soccer player when his football team announced that they needed a kicker. He tried the position, fell in love with it and then threw himself into it. He crossed state lines for camps and went to every coach he could find, looking to gain any knowledge that they could impart on him.

But after camps, trainings and teaching Doman all of the techniques they could, each of the coaches he went to gave him a similar message.

"Their main thing was, learn and be able to have a base of knowledge to coach yourself," Doman said. "Because in high school there's not a lot of kicking coaches. So you gotta be able to coach yourself."

Emulating the strict outlines his father Thomas — a colonel in the United States Marine Corps — set forth, Doman learned how to act as his own coach. He kicked for hours on empty fields. He analyzed his own film. He focused on athleticism in ways not expected of specialists. And he made routines for himself. **(Charlie Pappalardo, The Michigan Daily, September 22, 2023)**
