## FIRST-AND-10

**REID FERGUSON** originally joined the Bills as a rookie free agent in 2016 from LSU and was added to the practice squad later that year. In 2017, he became the team's primary long snapper and is currently the team's longest tenured player. In 2025, Ferguson signed a 4-year contract extension.

## SHOUTOUTS

- Holds the 2nd longest streak of consecutive games played in Bills history with 148 (trailing only Brian Moorman, 179)
- Appeared in all 16/17 games for the 9th consecutive season in 2025.
- Played in 100th career regular season game at Was. (9/24/23).
- In 2022, was part of a special teams unit that ranked 5th in the NFL (according to Rick Gosselin) and 1st in DVOA as calculated by Football Outsiders.
- He and his brother, Blake, played against each other for first time in their lives at Mia (9/20/20).
- The Bills are 9-3 when he records a tackle on special teams in his career.
- Served as LSU's long snapper for all 51 games of his collegiate career (2012-15) and only had one errant snap which occurred on his first snap as a freshman.
- Earned first-team All-America honors by Phil Steele in 2015.
- Rated as the nation's #2 long snapper coming out of high school by Scout.com and earned a scholarship to LSU.
- Earned a spot on the academic honor roll during all four years of college.
- Has visited 13 current MLB stadiums in his quest to see all 30 venues.

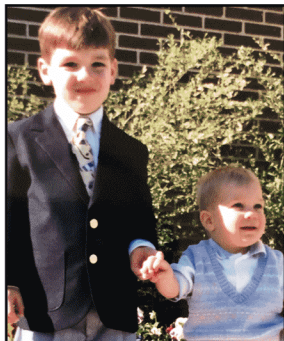


## PERSONAL

## BROTHERLY LOVE

Reid and Blake Ferguson took similar paths to the NFL growing up in Buford, GA. Both attended Buford HS and LSU. And both were rivals in the AFC East from 2020-24, as Blake was drafted by the Dolphins in 2020. Blake learned a great deal from his big brother over the years, but it was not a one-way street. "Perseverance is the best thing I learned from Blake," recalled Reid. "His battle with diabetes over the years put a lot of things in perspective for me. Things that seemed like big problems are nothing compared to what he went through."

## FIGHT FOR HIS FAMILY

Ferguson's brother, Blake, was diagnosed as a Type 1 diabetic in 2011 at the age of 13. Since then, it has been a family mission to raise awareness and funds to fight diabetes. In fact, during the 2018 offseason, he joined his brother and the American Diabetes Association in a trip to Capitol Hill to meet with lawmakers to raise awareness. "The experience I had at Call to Congress with the American Diabetes Association was very eye-opening," Ferguson told the Buffalo News. "To be able to go to the Hill and continue the talks to get more funding for diabetes research was incredible."

## SOCCER TEAM OWNER

In 2023, Reid and his brother, Blake, became minority owners of Swansea City AFC in Wales. "Sports ownership has always been a goal of mine and I love the game of soccer. It was an opportunity I could not pass up," said Ferguson.

In 2025, Ferguson also invested in a new professional soccer team in Buffalo. "As an adopted member of the Buffalo community, I could not be more excited to be a part of the Buffalo Pro Soccer project, bringing professional soccer to the Western New York area," Ferguson said.
