MIKE EDWARDS was signed by the Bills as an undrafted free agent in 2024. Edwards, who began his collegiate career at Wake Forest, was a two-time All-America selection at Campbell in 2022 and 2023.

SHOUTOUTS

- As Campbell's starting left tackle, earned 2023 Stats Perform FCS All-American honors becoming Campbell's first two-time All-American.
- Also earned first team All-CAA honors in 2023, helping Campbell to over 400 yards of total offense 6 times.
 Campbell's offensive line ranked No. 2 in the FCS in pass blocking efficiency (93.2), according to PFF.
- The 2023 Camels offense led the CAA and stood 5th nationally in pass completion percentage (.702), 10th in first down offense (250), 15th in third down conversion percentage (.454) and 17th overall in team passing efficiency (150.84).
- Led the way up front in a 613-yard performance (353 passing, 260 rushing) in a victory at The Citadel (9/9/23).
- In 2022, earned All-America honors from both the AFCA and Phil Steele. Became the 5th Camel all-time to earn All-America honors.
- Anchored the left side of an offensive line that helped CU set a single season passing yards record for the second straight year.
- Paved the way for the Camels to gain 315 rushing yards in a win over NC Central (10/1/22).
- In 2021, started the first seven games at left tackle and helped the CU offense set a school record for passing yards (2,901) and passing touchdowns (24).
- Started all 4 games at left tackle in his first season as a Camel in 2020.
- At Wake Forest, missed the 2019 season due to injury after redshirting in 2018.

IF YOU HAVEN'T HERD FROM THE TROMBONE TO ALL-AMERICAN

Campbell University's football team has set new school passing records the past couple of seasons. Coaches will point to left tackle Mike Edwards as one of the biggest reasons why the Camels have been able to move the ball up and down the field with much more precision.

Now a graduate student in Buies Creek, he has been named a preseason All-American by Stats Perform, Phil Steele College Football and The Bluebloods.

Edwards first started out in the band, playing trombone. But someone invited him to try out for football in high school, and the rest is history. While playing at South View, he emerged as one of the top recruits in North Carolina.

In 2022, Edwards became the first Campbell offensive lineman to earn All-American recognition, being voted to the American Football Coaches Association second-team for FCS. (Eric Lusk, NC Football News, August 23, 2023)
