KAMERON CLINE joined the Bills in 2023 and spent his first season on the practice squad and signed a reserve/futures contract on January 22, 2024 after entering the NFL in 2020 as an undrafted free agent with the Indianapolis Colts where he spent the 2020-22 seasons. He previously spent four seasons (2016-19) at South Dakota.

SHOUTOUTS

- Has seen action in five games and tallied three tackles (two solo) in his career.
- Appeared in 43 games (28 starts) at South Dakota and 121 tackles (67 solo), 22 tackles for loss, seven sacks, one pass defensed, two forced fumbles, two fumble recoveries and one blocked kick.
- During his senior season in 2019, played in all 12 games (10 starts) and finished with 36 tackles (21 solo), 10 tackles for loss, four sacks, one pass defensed, one forced fumble and one fumble recovery.
- Started seven games in 2018 and tallied 22 tackles (15 solo), 7.5 tackles for loss, one sack, one forced fumble and one fumble recovery.
- In 2017, saw action in all 13 games (11 starts) and registered 40 tackles (20 solo), 1.5 tackles for loss and one fumble recovery.
- As a true freshman in 2016, played in all 11 games and recorded 23 tackles (11 solo), 3.0 tackles for loss and two sacks.

Son of Shawn Cline and the late Amy Cline. Got his degree in the spring of 2023 in General Studies at the University of South Dakota. Native of San Diego, California and attended Patrick Henry High School where he also played tight end where he caught 21 passes for 300 yards and four touchdowns, played basketball for the Patriots as well.
