

### **FIRST-AND-10**

**ALEC ANDERSON** signed with the Bills as an undrafted free agent in 2022 and earned a roster spot in 2023. Anderson, who started 20 games at right tackle during a four-year stint at UCLA from 2018-21, spent his rookie season on the Bills practice squad.

### SHOUTOUTS

- Started and played all 67 snaps at LG at NE (1/5/25).
- Recovered a fumble on a kickoff return at Ind. (11/10/24).
- Saw action in his first NFL game vs. Arz. (9/8/24) and made first NFL start as a 6th lineman at NYJ (10/14/24).
- Earned a spot on the Bills 53-man roster in 2023 but was inactive for every game. Spent his rookie season of 2022 on the Bills practice squad.
- Played in 30 games (20 starts as a right tackle) during a four-year career at UCLA (2018-21).
- Started 10 games at right tackle in 2021 for the highest scoring team in the Pac-12 (36.5 points per game).
- Also helped pave the way for the Bruins to average over 200 yards per game on the ground for the second straight season (215.1) and produce a 1,000-yard rusher in Zach Charbonnet (1,137).
- In 2020, started all 7 games at RT as UCLA had a rushing average of 230.6 yards per game (2nd in Pac-12).
- Played in 10 games, including his first three career starts, in 2019 and helped block for RB Joshua Kelley who became the 8th running back in UCLA history to record back-to-back 1,000-yard rushing seasons.
- Saw action in three games as a freshman in 2018.
