BAYLON SPECTOR was selected by the Bills in the 7th round (231st overall) in 2022 and has provided depth at linebacker in his first three NFL seasons. Spector had 210 tackles during his five-year collegiate career at Clemson (2017-21).

SHOUTOUTS

- Registered first career NFL sack with a takedown of Lamar Jackson at Bal. (9/29/24). Also posted 6 tackles and his first career fumble recovery.
- Started first regular season game vs. Jax. (9/23/24) and finished with 6 tackles.
- Subbed for an injured Terrel Bernard at Mia. (9/12/24) and had a career-high 10 tackles, including 1 for a loss.
- Started first career game in the AFC Wild Card round vs. Pit. (1/15/24).
- Posted 4 tackles in AFC East division clinching win at Mia. (1/7/24).
- Saw action in 6 games as a rookie with the Bills in 2022 with 4 tackles on defense and 2 more on special teams.
- Made his NFL debut on special teams at LAR (9/8/22).
- Played in 53 games during his career at Clemson from 2017-21 and finished with 210 tackles (22.0 for loss), 9 sacks, 4 forced fumbles, 4 fumble recoveries, 3 passes defended and an interception.
- Ranked 2nd on the team with 85 tackles in 2021, while also recording 4.5 tackles for loss, 2.5 sacks, an interception, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery in 11 games (10 starts). Served as team captain.
- His 19 tackles at NC State (9/25/21) were the most by a Clemson player in a single game since 2002.
- Played in 12 games in 2020 and earned second team All-ACC honors from the Associated Press with a team leading 72 tackles to go along with 10.5 tackles for loss, 4.5 sacks, two forced fumbles and a fumble recovery.
