

# **FIRST-AND-10**

CASEY TOOHILL signed a one-year contract with the Bills on March 19, 2024. A 7th round draft choice of Philadelphia in 2020, he appeared in 1 game with the Eagles as a rookie before being acquired off waivers by Washington on October 14, 2020. He went on to see action in 56 regular season games (14 starts) with Washington.

#### **SHOUTOUTS**

- Posted a sack and a fumble recovery vs. Jax. (9/23/24).
- Notched a career-high 5 sacks for the Commanders in 2023 in 16 games (8 starts) while seeing action in a career-high 45% of their defensive snaps. Also totaled 27 tackles, 6 for a loss and a fumble recovery.
- Registered a fumble recovery at NYJ (12/24/23).
- Recorded a career-high 2 sacks of Desmond Ridder in a victory at Atl. (10/15/23).
- In 2022, played in 16 games and recorded 23 tackles, a sack, 6 QB hits and 2 fumbles recovered.
- Took down Deshaun Watson for his only sack of the 2022 season vs. Cle. (1/1/23). Also had 3 tackles.
- Recovered a fumble and returned it one yard for his first NFL TD at Phi. (11/14/22).
- Started 6 games of the 16 total contests for Washington in 2021 with 22 tackles, a sack, and a pass defensed.
- Registered a career-high 5 tackles vs. his former team vs. Phi. (1/2/22).
- Posted his first career sack of Patrick Mahomes vs. KC (10/17/21).
- Played in his only career playoff contest vs. TB in the NFC Wild Card game (1/9/21).
- Made NFL debut for the Eagles vs. LA Rams (9/20/20).
- During his career at Stanford (2016-19), saw action in 46 games and posted 130 tackles (70 solo), 14.5 sacks, an interception, 3 passes defensed and a fumble recovery.

## IF YOU HAVEN'T HERD "FELL IN LOVE WITH THE POSITION"

"Baseball was my favorite sport growing up because that is what my brother played, and I was interested in collecting baseball cards and balls," Toohill told BVM Sports in 2021.

He eventually turned all of his attention to flag football. "My parents didn't want me to play Pop Warner until I was a little bit older, which I thought was a smart decision," Toohill said.

But when he entered the 8th grade, and his interest continued to deepen, his parents eventually allowed him to play Pop Warner. Because of his quickness and 5-foot-8 stature, his Pop Warner coaches played him as a running back. However, his position changed when Toohill began high school at Cathedral Catholic in San Diego. During his first two years, Toohill had a massive growth spurt in which he sprouted to 6-foot-1 and was eventually called up to be an outside linebacker.
