ZION LOGUE (rhymes with ROGUE) signed with the Bills on October 1, 2024 via the Falcons practice squad. Logue originally entered the NFL in 2024 as a sixth round pick (197th overall) of Atlanta. Logue was released by the Falcons prior to the start of the 2024 season and signed with their practice squad.

SHOUTOUTS

- After being signed off the Falcons practice squad on October 1, made his NFL debut for the Bills five days later at Hou. (10/6/24) and recorded 2 tackles in 20 snaps on defense.
- Saw action in all three games for the Falcons in the 2024 preseason and made 3 tackles.
- Played in 50 games during his five year at Georgia (2019-23) and was a member of the Bulldogs national championship squads in both 2021 and 2022.
- Notched 52 career tackles, 1.5 sacks, 4 passes defensed a forced fumble and a fumble recovery.
- In 2023, saw action in all 14 games (10 starts) and posted 17 tackles, 3 passes defensed, 3 for a loss, and 0.5 sacks.
- Saw action in 14 games (6 starts) in 2022 and tallied 16 tackles, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery and a pass defensed.
- Registered 11 tackles, including a sack in 2021 while playing in 15 games.
- Posted his first career sack in a win at Auburn (10/9/21) after taking down Bo Nix.
- Saw action in 5 games in 2020 and recorded a careerhigh 5 tackles in a win at South Carolina (11/28/20).
- Played in 2 games as a true freshman in 2019.

LEADING HIS OWN WAY

For Zion Logue, it's more about the journey and how he navigated that trip that has him held in such high esteem and a key member of Kirby Smart's leadership core. Perhaps by default, Logue has also assumed the role of "vocal leader" for this group, although speaking up and speaking out may not quite be his style.

"That's something I need to do and I try to do," Logue said.
"Whether it's cheering my guys on, whether it's leading
by example, actually striking guys, actually running to the
football, actually knowing my assignments, executing my
assignments, that plays a big role if people listen to you."

"Don't look at it as pressure," Logue said. "Look at it as you're getting prepared for it every week. Our practices are harder than our games and we make it that way because by the time Saturday gets here, you've seen every play. You've seen everything that they can do, and now you've just got to go react and play."

Kirby Smart sums up Logue this way: "Zion is a guy that's been kind of a product of our environment—culture I might say. He's seen leaders before him. He certainly had a long way to go when he got here, but he never shied away from work. He's been very consistent in his work," Smart said. "He's worked really hard to earn the opportunity he's gotten. He would be the first to tell you there are things he can do better. But he's a great leader. He makes up for what he may or may not have in complete talent with effort, toughness, all the things we think are quality leadership things, and he continues to do that."
