FIRST-AND-10

TERREL BERNARD was selected by the Bills in the third round (89th overall) in 2022 after spending his collegiate career at Baylor. In his second year in Buffalo, Bernard led the Bills in total tackles with 143 and ranked 8th in the AFC.

SHOUTOUTS

- Collected eight tackles and two TFLs vs TEN (10/20/24) he also pulled in his first fumble recovery of the season.
- Caught his first interception of 2024 picking off C.J. Stroud at HOU (10/6/24) and collected one pass defensed and five total tackles.
- Recorded a game high 11 total tackles in the season opener vs ARI (9/8/24).
- Bernard joined Greg Lloyd 1989 (PIT), Richard Dent 1990 (CHI), Seth Joyner 1991 (PHI) as the only players since 1982 to have recorded 6+ sacks, 3+ INTs and 3+ fumble recoveries in one season.
- Finished the 2023 season with a team high 143 total tackles, the most tackles by any Bill in a season since 2017 (Preston Brown-144).
- Totaled 6.5 sacks on the season the highest by a Bills linebacker since Lorenzo Alexander had 6.5 in 2018.
- Recorded 2 sacks vs NE (12/31/23) for his 2nd career multi-sack game (had 2 at WAS 9/24/23).
- Recorded a sack at LAC (12/23/23) and finished the game with seven tackles adding a QB hit and a TFL.
- Caught his third interception of the season, picking off Jalen Hurts at PHI (11/26/23) and collected five tackles raising his season total to 104. Reached the 100-tackle milestone for the first time in his career.

THE CAPTAIN

For the start of the 2024 season Terrel Bernard was selected by his peers as one of two captains of the Bills.

"It's an honor and one I don't take lightly, to be in a room with All-Pros, Hall of Famers and just NFL players in general, it means a lot. I just want to go out there everyday and compete and continue to lead by example continue to communicate properly." He echoed this to Tim Graham of the Athletic. "My focus is on finding ways to improve, not just me, but everybody in that building. It's time to take another step and excel from last year.



LEAD THE WAY

Bernard didn't just earn the respect of his teammates at Baylor because of his all-Big 12 caliber play. He also earned it through the hard work he put in to overcome injuries and through his ability to lead others.

He didn't show up at Baylor ready to lead as a freshman and made sure to observe the veterans ahead of him to see the right way to do things.

"I think it's something you learn," Bernard said to the Waco Tribune-Herald. "It helps to see other leaders and take things from them. So I think I've taken bits and pieces from players and coaches, and people outside of football. I kind of tried to implement that into my personality and try to get the best from people around me. I think that's what being a leader is all about."

"Terrel is a physical and a tough guy," Baylor head coach Dave Aranda said. "He feels a lot, and he's got a great heart, and I think things really matter to him. It's more than lip service with him."
