SPENCER BROWN signed a four-year contract extension with the Bills on September 6, 2024, tying him to the team through 2028. Brown was drafted by Buffalo in the third round (93rd overall) of the 2021 draft. Prior to joining the Bills, he played at Northern Iowa from 2016-20. Brown is the first Bill ever drafted from Northern Iowa.

SHOUTOUTS

- Started 15 games at RT in 2024 for an offensive line that only allowed an NFL-best 14 sacks, the fewest by any team since 2009.
- Started all 17 regular season games at RT in 2023 for a Bills offensive line that allowed the fewest amount of sacks in the league (24). Paved the way for RB James Cook who ranked second in the AFC with 1,122 rushing yards.
- Has started all six career playoffs games he's appeared in at RT.
- Started 14 regular season games and both playoff matchups in 2022.
- As a rookie in 2021, started 10 games in the regular season and two playoff contests.
- Made first NFL start vs. HOU (10/4/21).
- Played in 33 games with 32 starts during his time at Northern lowa.
- Was named a preseason FCS All-American in 2020 before the season was postponed.

LOYALTY TO NORTHERN IOWA

When the Missouri Valley Conference postponed the 2020 season to the spring of 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, it was a true shot to the gut of Spencer Brown. Everything had been building to his senior year. He had high hopes not just for himself individually, but also for his team. From his point of view, Northern Iowa had a real chance at a championship.

When the news broke, coaches from Power 5 schools started reaching out to Brown in hopes he was going to transfer in order to bolster his draft stocks. Brown quickly put that to bed because there was no way he was going to be a part of anything that wasn't at Northern Iowa.

"I am not going to let someone else reap the benefits of what UNI did for me," he wrote on his Twitter account. "I did not want to go somewhere and be under a system of guys that didn't like me from the start. I'd never do that."

"It's as simple as that," Brown said to The Athletic. "I can't imagine playing with a bunch of guys that aren't my guys here."
