ELIJAH MOORE signed as a free agent with the Bills on May 5, 2025. Moore originally entered the NFL in 2021 as a second round of the New York Jets, spending two years (2021-22) with the Jets before being traded to the Cleveland Browns (2023-24) along with a third round pick in exchange for a 2023 second round pick.

SHOUTOUTS

- Has started 40-of-61 career games played, accumulating 60 catches for 2,162 yards and nine TDs.
- Set career highs for receptions (61) in 2024. Added 538 receiving yards and one TD while playing in all 17 games with 13 starts.
- Recorded a career-high in receiving yards (640) in 2023 on 59 catches with two TDs.
- Registered a career-high nine receptions vs. Ten. (9/23/23).
- Played in his first career playoff game at Hou. (1/13/24), catching two passes for 12 yards.
- Posted 37 receptions for 446 yards and a touchdown in 16 games played in 2022.
- Led the Jets in receiving yards (538) in 2021, the team's first rookie to do so since 1995. Also led the team with six total touchdowns (five receiving, one rushing), a top-ten rank among all NFL rookies.

The Jets drafted Elijah Moore due in large part to his big-play ability and his knack for making things happen when his number is called. New York's electric rookie did just that over the weekend. This time, however, the highlight came off the field in the form of a heartwarming surprise for the woman who raised him

Moore presented his mother, Elisa, with a check representing his intention to pay off all of her debts. Video on Moore's social media accounts indicates that the check is worth \$70,000. It was revealed during what appeared to be a birthday celebration for Elisa in Miami. "The things that I do will never make up for anything that you guys have done for me, particularly my mother," Moore said. "I just wanted to do something small for you... I wanted to add a little something, a little trip for my mom because she deserves the world. "I'm going to pay off all your debt. You don't got to worry about nothing... You're going to live how you want and we'll just keep going up because you deserve it, mom. I want to give you the world. I want to give everybody here the world because you guys are family."

Explaining his mindset behind his work ethic during a 2023 interview, Moore detailed: "After every camp we used to come together and say 'One day better. One percent better.' I kind of move like that in everything I do. During a workout, when they say do 10, I do 12. When they say do 9, I do 10. Whatever it is. Every time I work out, it is intense like that. That is getting the most of of my workout. I'm not going out there just to say I worked out. I'm going out there to focus on something I feel like I was bad at and need to get better at. Get that one percent."
