VON MILLER signed a 6-year contract with the Bills on March 17, 2022 after helping the Rams capture Super Bowl LVI. The 2nd overall pick in 2011 by Denver, Miller spent the first 10+ seasons of his career with the Broncos before being traded to the Rams on November 2, 2021. One of the league's all-time prolific pass rushers, the 8-time Pro Bowler leads the NFL in sacks since entering the league.

SHOUTOUTS

- The future Hall of Famer's career: 8 Pro Bowl selections, three 1st-team All-Pro honors, four 2nd-team All-Pro honors, two Super Bowl championships, a Super Bowl MVP award, defensive rookie of the year honors, and a spot on the NFL's All-Decade team of the 2010's.
- Leads all players in sacks since entering the NFL in 2011 (129.5). Ranks 16th on the NFL's all-time list.
- Tied for 11th in NFL history with 10.5 sacks in the postseason. Tied with Charles Haley for most sacks in Super Bowl history (4.5).
- Recorded the 5th-most sacks all-time in a single decade (112.5) from 2010-19.
- Is Denver's all-time leader in sacks (110.5).
- Registered 2 sacks of Patrick Mahomes in win at KC (9/16/22).
- Posted two sacks at LAR (9/8/22), his 4th multi-sack outing on opening day.
- Recorded 2 sacks for the Rams in their Super Bowl LVI win vs. Cin. (2/13/22).
- Named Super Bowl 50 MVP for Denver with 6 tackles, 2.5 sacks, and 2 forced fumbles in 24-10 win vs. Car. (2/7/16).
- Named NFL Defensive Rookie of the Year in 2011 after tallying 11.5 sacks.

VON'S VISION

Inspired by his own vision issues growing up, Miller created Von's Vision Foundation in 2012.

The mission of Von's Vision is to provide low-income students with eye care and fashionable corrective eye wear they need to be their best in the classroom and in life.

Since its inception, Von's Vision has gifted over \$5.1 million in eye care and eye wear to students in need across the country.

"I wear glasses, they wear glasses and if we don't connect any other way, we both wear glasses and we both struggle with our vision," Miller said "And you can be cool doing it."

PASS RUSH SUMMIT

The future Hall of Famer conducts his annual Von Miller Pass Rush Summit each summer in Nevada, a two-day event which attracts players from around the NFL. "To be able to walk and talk and go through moves and mindset with guys around the league I respect is huge for me," Miller told the Buffalo News. "I'm a pass rusher and this is a fraternity of brothers. I want all these guys to have success."



FUTURE GENERAL MANAGER

Miller has made it no secret he aspires to become an NFL general manager once his playing days are over. He uses as much time as possible to soak in knowledge from Bills general manager Brandon Beane, including a job shadow experience at the 2023 NFL Combine.

"He's just a great human being," Miller told the Buffalo News of Beane. "He opened the door. He watered my plant. He easily could have said, 'Man, you oughta be focused on football,' which I would have gladly did, but for him to water the plant for me is great. And I just feel extremely humbled and blessed to have this opportunity here at the combine."

"I can't just stay boxed in. I got to be able to plan and forecast: 'OK, when this doesn't work, what am I going to do next?' You got to be able to balance those two things."

"There are moments in life where you... have to be where your feet are," Miller said. "There are moments, too, where I gotta be here, but I still gotta be looking for what's next."
