A CONSISTENTLY-DOMINANT DUO

• Mike Evans (1,124) and Chris Godwin (1,023) each surpassed the 1,000-yard receiving mark this season, marking the fourth time in franchise history that multiple Buccaneers surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in the same season (2014, 2019, 2021, 2022). Evans and Godwin have accounted for the past three-such occasions.



• Evans and Godwin were 1-of-5 sets of teammates this season to go over 1,000 yards each.

• Brady finished the 2022 season third in passing yards with 4,694. Since arriving in Tampa Bay in 2020, his 14,643 passing yards trail only Patrick Mahomes.



• In Week 18, Brady threw his 25th touchdown pass of the season, surpassing Pro Football Hall of Famer Peyton Manning for the most 25-touchdown seasons in NFL history.

• Since the start of the 2020 season, Tampa Bay ranks first in sacks allowed per pass attempt (3.1%) and leads the NFL in most games without allowing a sack (16). The Buccaneers finished first in the NFL in 2022 in both fewest sacks allowed (22) and fewest sacks per pass attempt (2.8%).

LIGHT ON PUBLICITY, HEAVY ON PRODUCTION



Defensive captain **Lavonte David** surpassed the 100-tackle mark for the season and finished tied for the team lead with 124 tackles. His nine seasons for Tampa Bay with 100+ tackles are the second-most in Buccaneers history, trailing only Pro Football Hall of Famer Derrick Brooks.

In Week 16, he notched the 43rd 10-tackle performance of his career, surpassing Derrick Brooks (42) for the most double-digit tackle games in franchise history, according to Pro Football Reference.

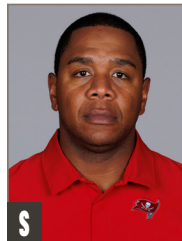

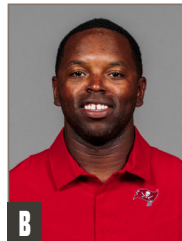

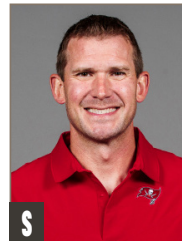

MIKE MCCARTHY



The Dallas Cowboys named Mike McCarthy the ninth head coach in franchise history on Jan. 8, 2020.

McCarthy came to Dallas with 13 years of head coaching experience and 13 additional years as an assistant coach in the NFL, including six as an offensive coordinator.

As a head coach, McCarthy has racked up a 155-97-2 regular season record - with the Green Bay Packers (2006-18) and Dallas Cowboys (2020-Present) - and he owns the fifth-most wins (tied for 25th all-time) among active NFL coaches. His teams have

qualified for the postseason 10 times, won seven division titles, made four NFC Championship Game appearances and took home a Super Bowl XLV championship.

MIKE MCCARTHY AT A GLANCE

- McCarthy's second season in Dallas included an NFC East division title, a 12-5 record and a sweep of the Cowboys' division rivals. Dallas set a franchise record with 530 points scored to lead the NFL in scoring, while also leading the league in total offense. The team set an NFL record with 22 different players scoring a touchdown for a team in a single season and the Cowboys led the NFL in turnover differential (+14) and finished second in points off takeaways (119).
- In his first season, McCarthy guided the Cowboys to a 6-10 record, while overcoming four different starting quarterbacks and eight starting offensive line combinations. In total, the club lost 152 games played and 127 starts to injury.
- McCarthy launched his head coaching career with Green Bay on Jan. 12, 2006, and in 12-plus years as their head coach, he guided one of the most successful stretches in franchise history, reaching the postseason in eight consecutive seasons (2009-16). With his Super Bowl XLV victory, McCarthy joined Vince Lombardi and Mike Holmgren as the only coaches to guide the Packers to a Super Bowl win.
- Known as a prolific offensive mind - and the primary play-caller - McCarthy's Packers offense finished fourth in the NFL in total offense (364.4) and third in points-per-game (26.0) in total through his tenure with the club. Behind the arm of Aaron Rodgers, over that same span, the Packers were third in passing offense. Additionally, over the course of 13 years with the Packers, his offenses regularly ranked in the top 10 in passing yards (10 times), total offense (nine) and scoring offense (nine).
- In Week 6 of 2015, McCarthy earned the 100th regular season win of his career in just his 150th game, making him the seventh-fastest coach in NFL history and the then fastest current NFL coach to reach the 100-win plateau. Two years later in Week 6 of 2017, McCarthy coached his 200th career game, including postseason, and having compiled 128 victories, he tied Bud Grant and Chuck Noll for the sixth-most wins by a head coach through 200 games.
- McCarthy is only the fourth head coach in NFL history to lead a single franchise to eight-or-more consecutive playoff appearances, joining Tom Landry, Noll and Bill Belichick. Those eight appearances from 2009-16 were more than the rest of the NFC North Division combined over that span (Minnesota, three; Detroit, three; Chicago, one).
