BACK FOR ANOTHER CHANCE AT HISTORY



TOM BRADY VS. ATLANTA

- 8-0 record vs. the Falcons, including postseason the best W/L vs. Atlanta by any player in NFL history.
- Brady-led teams have averaged 30.4 points per game in those eight wins vs. Atlanta

ONE TEAM ONE CAUSE

CONSECUTIVE WINS WHILE SCORING 30+ POINTS - TIED FOR THE LONGEST STREAK IN NFL HISTORY

- Tied for the longest streak in NFL history with the 2007 and 2010 New England Patriots.
- Tom Brady was the starting QB for all three streaks. Brady was named NFL MVP following both the 2007 and 2010 seasons.
- The Buccaneers current winning streak while scoring 30+ points in each game started in Week 15 of the 2020 season at Atlanta and continued through the 2020 playoffs.
- The Buccaneers have won nine consecutive games overall dating back to Week 14 of 2020. A win vs. Atlanta would give Tampa Bay its first 10-game win streak in team history.

THE GREATEST OF ALL TIME

· Tom Brady finished his first season in Tampa Bay with 40 touchdown passes (the most ever by a player in his first season with a team) and 4,633 passing yards (the second-most ever by a player in his first season with a team). He ranked tied for second in the NFL



in touchdowns and third in the NFL in passing yards during the 2020 season and remains in the top five in 2020.

GETTING RED ZONE RESULTS



- · The Buccaneers offense scored a touchdown on 42-of-61 trips inside the red zone in 2020, while leading the NFL with a 95.1 scoring percentage (58-of-61) on red zone drives.
- · The team found success through the air in the red zone, recording 31 red zone passing touchdowns, tied for the second-most in the NFL since 2020.

· With 1,006 yards in 2020, Mike Evans became the first player in NFL history with 1,000-or-more receiving yards in each of his first seven NFL seasons, surpassing Randy Moss (first six seasons).



· Evans set a new franchise record with 13 receiving

touchdowns (fourth in the NFL) and is Tampa Bay's all-time leader in receptions, receiving yards and receiving touchdowns.



HC BRUCE ARIANS

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X In addition to leading the Buccaneers to a Super Bowl LV title in 2020, Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on Jan 8, 2019.
- X In 2020, Arians led Tampa Bay to 11 wins, tying its second-most in team history. The Buccaneers also clinched their first playoff berth since 2007 and won the franchise's second Super Bowl. Arians' team ranked first in rush defense, third in scoring, fourth in pass offense, sixth in total defense and seventh in total offense.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X In 2019, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense and ranking third in the NFL in total offense. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL singlegame rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

Arthur Smith was named the 18th head coach in Atlanta Falcons history on January 15, 2021 and takes over the club after serving as the Tennessee Titans offensive coordinator for the last two seasons (2019-2020). During that span, Smith orchestrated one of the NFL's top offenses with the Titans leading the league in red-zone touchdown percentage (75.2), ranking fifth points per game (27.9) and fifth in total offense (379.6). He oversaw the second-ranked rushing attack in the NFL, averaging 153.5 yards per game on the ground.

ARTHUR SMITH AT A GLANCE

- Over the last two seasons, the Titans have been among the league's best in the red zone. The club's 75.6 (2019) and 75.0 (2020) red zone touchdown percentages are the fourth and fifthbest single-season marks by a team since 2000.
- In 2020, Smith's offense averaged 30.7 points per game and 491 total points which was good for fourth in the NFL. He also oversaw one of the most potent rushing attacks in league history as Derrick Henry became just the eighth player in NFL history to rush for more than 2,000 yards in a single season. Henry's 2,027 rushing yards rank fifth all-time and paced the Titans to the league's second-best rushing offense in 2020, trailing only the Baltimore Ravens.
- Smith also has been credited with revitalizing the career of quarterback Ryan Tannehill. In two seasons running Smith's offense, Tannehill started 26 games and totaled 6,561 passing yards with 55 touchdowns, 13 interceptions, and a 110.6 passer rating, while completing 67.3 percent of his passes. Tannehill was named to the Pro Bowl in 2019 after leading the NFL with a 117.5 passer rating and was named the Comeback Player of the Year by both the Associated Press and the PFWA.
- In 2019, Smith helped lead the Titans to the team's first AFC Championship Game appearance in 17 years. In his first season as offensive coordinator, the Titans led the NFL in red-zone efficiency (75.6 percent), ranked third in rushing offense (138.9 yards per game), and fourth in yards per play (6.12).
- In Tennessee, Smith worked his way up from his 2011 position
 of defensive assistant/quality control coach. He also spent time
 as an offensive assistant/quality control coach (2012), offensive
 line/tight ends assistant (2013), and assistant tight ends coach
 (2014-15) before taking over as tight ends coach during the 2015
 season and holding the position through 2018.
- Prior to joining the Titans, Smith spent two years as the defensive quality control coach for the Washington Football Team from 2007-08. He also worked as a college scouting assistant in Washington in 2007. In 2010, Smith worked at Ole Miss as an administrative assistant/defensive intern, primarily working with the linebackers.
- Smith graduated from North Carolina where he played offensive line and later joined the Tar Heels coaching staff as a graduate assistant (2006), working with the offensive line. Born and raised in Memphis, Tenn., he went to high school at Georgetown Prep (North Bethesda, Md.). Smith and his wife, Allison, currently live in Nashville with their two sons, Tanner and Liam, and their daughter, Sophie.
