

A STINGY DEFENSE



The Buccaneers have allowed the fourth-fewest points (104) and tied for the third-fewest touchdowns (nine) this season.

Inside the redzone, Tampa Bay ranks first in lowest opponent redzone touchdown percentage allowed (22.2%). tied for first in takeaways (three) and second in fewest yards per play allowed (1.7).

Opponents have converted just two of their last 14 red zone drives into touchdowns vs. the Buccaneers dating back to Week 3.

OFFENSIVE NOTES

A CONSISTENTLY-DOMINANT DUO

· Mike Evans (1,124) and Chris Godwin (1,023) each surpassed the 1,000-yard receiving mark last season, marking the fourth time in franchise history that multiple Buccaneers surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in the same season (2014, 2019, 2021, 2022). Evans and Godwin have accounted for the past three such occasions.



 \cdot Evans and Godwin were 1-of-5 sets of teammates last season to go over 1,000 yards each.

PROFICIENCY IN PASS PROTECTION

· Since the arrival of All-Pro tackle Tristan Wirfs in 2020, Tampa Bay ranks first in sacks allowed per pass attempt (3.1%) and leads the NFL in most games without allowing a sack (17). So far in 2023, the Buccaneers have allowed just eight sacks through Week 7 (2nd in the NFL).

RAISING THE LEVEL IN THE REDZONE



- \cdot Through Week 7, Tampa Bay has allowed its opponents to reach the end zone on just 22.2% of redzone drives, the best defensive mark in the NFL this season. Tampa Bay's four redzone touchdowns are also tied for the fewest allowed in the NFL this season.
- · The Buccaneers have allowed just 1.7 yards per play inside the redzone, which ranks second in the NFL.



MIKE EVANS

- Needs 1 receiving touchdown to tie Jimmy Graham (86) for the 17th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs **2 receiving touchdowns** to tie Andre Reed (87) for the 16th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs 3 receiving touchdowns to tie Don Maynard (88) for the 15th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs 58 receiving yards to surpass Joey Galloway (10,950) for the 39th-most receiving yards in NFL history.
- Needs 107 receiving yards to become the first player in team history to surpass the 11,000-yard receiving mark with the Buccaneers.
- Needs 167 receiving yards to surpass Chad Johnson (11,059) for the 38th-most receiving yards in NFL history.

CHRIS GODWIN

- Needs 1 receiving touchdown to tie Cameron Brate (33) for the third-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Needs 2 receiving touchdowns to tie Jimmie Giles (34) for the second-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Needs 1 touchdown to tie Jimmie Giles (34) for the fourth-most touchdowns from scrimmage in franchise history.





ADDITIONAL NOTES

Sean McDermott was named head coach of the Bills on January 11, 2017 after spending six seasons as the defensive coordinator of the Carolina Panthers.

McDermott has coached the Bills to five playoff appearances in his first six seasons for a franchise that had last experienced a postseason berth in 1999. He became just the third coach in Bills history to earn a playoff berth in his first season at the helm, joining Joe Collier (1966) and Wade Phillips (1998). - McDermott ranks first in team history in winning percentage and third in franchise history in wins behind only Marv Levy (123) and Lou Saban (70).
- McDermott is a three-time finalist for the NFL's Coach of the Year Award: 2022, 2020 and 2019.
- In 2022, Buffalo went 13-3, finishing with the second-best record in the AFC, while also capturing the AFC East division title. They defeated the Miami Dolphins 34-31 in the Wild Card Round prior to falling 27-10 to the Cincinanti Bengals in the Divisional Round.
- Eight Bills were selected to the Pro Bowl in 2022, including Josh Allen, Stefon Diggs, Dion Dawkins, Dawson Knox, Matt Milano, Rodger Saffold, Jordan Poyer and Mitch Morse.
- In 2021, the Bills defense led the NFL in fewest points allowed per game (17.0) for the first time in franchise history and also finished first in fewest yards allowed per game (272.8) and fewest passing yards allowed per game (163.0).

- McDermott was hired by the Bills after 6 seasons as the defensive coordinator in Carolina, where he led a top-10 defense four times and helped the Panthers earn three division titles and a trip to Super Bowl 50.
- He spent his first 12 NFL seasons with Philadelphia, working his way up to defensive coordinator in 2009-10. He joined the Eagles in 1998 as a scouting administrative coordinator before being promoted to assistant to the head coach under Andy Reid in 1999.
- A member of the William & Mary Athletics Hall of Fame, McDermott was an All-Atlantic 10 Conference choice at safety in 1997 and graduated with a degree in finance. He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater in 1998. He was a teammate of Steelers Head Coach Mike Tomlin.
- Sean and his wife, Jamie, have three children. His father, Rich, was a football coach at West Chester and Ursinsus and his brother, Tim, is the Chief Business Officer of the Philadelphia Union (MLS). McDermott was born in Omaha, Nebraska.




