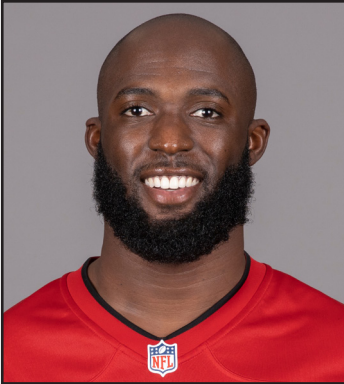

- Cornerbacks Coach **Kevin Ross** was drafted by Kansas City in 1984 and spent 10 seasons with the organization (1984-93) before returning in 1997 for the final season of his NFL career.

PLAYER/COACH CONNECTIONS

- Buccaneers QB **Tom Brady** (2000-19) played for the New England Patriots when Chiefs Wide Receivers Coach **Greg Lewis** was a receiver in New England in 2009. Chiefs Linebackers Coach **Brendan Daly** was also with the Patriots at this time (2014-18) and served as a defensive assistant and defensive line coach.
- Buccaneers Head Coach **Todd Bowles** was the interim head coach of the Miami Dolphins in 2011 when Chiefs QB **Chad Henne** (2008-11) played for the organization.
- Buccaneers Head Strength & Conditioning Coach **Anthony Piroli** (2014, 2018) and Assistant Strength & Conditioning Coach **Cory Bichey** (2018-19) worked with Kansas City LB **Willie Gay** (2017-19) and DT **Chris Jones** (2013-15) at Mississippi State.
- Chiefs Offensive Line Coach **Andy Heck** served as an offensive assistant (2004-12) for the Jacksonville Jaguars while QB **Blaine Gabbert** played for the Jaguars (2011-13).



COACHING CONNECTIONS



- Buccaneers General Manager **Jason Licht** worked in the personnel department for the Philadelphia Eagles from 2003-07 while Chiefs Head Coach **Andy Reid** (1999-2012) coached the Eagles. The Eagles finished first in the NFC East in three of the five years Licht and Reid worked together, including a 2004 season that saw the franchise post a 13-3 regular season record and advance to Super Bowl XXXIX.
- Buccaneers Head Coach **Todd Bowles** spent the 2012 season in Philadelphia as the secondary coach/interim defensive coordinator, working under Chiefs Head Coach **Andy Reid** (1999-2012).
- Buccaneers Offensive Line Coach **Joe Gilbert** (1994-99) was the offensive line coach and offensive coordinator at Maine when Chiefs Defensive Coordinator **Steve Spagnuolo** (1993-94) was the defensive coordinator for the program in the 1994 season.
- Chiefs Defensive Backs Coach **Dave Merritt** (2018) served as the defensive backs coach for the Arizona Cardinals when Buccaneers Offensive Coordinator **Byron Leftwich** (2016-18), Inside Linebackers/Pass Game Coordinator **Larry Foote** (2015-18) and Wide Receivers Coach **Kevin Garver** (2013-18) were with the team.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X Named 2014 Assistant Coach of the Year by the Pro Football Writers Association and the Associated Press.
- X The architect of Tampa Bay's Super Bowl LV-winning defense during the 2020 NFL season.
- X Bowles' defenses have finished inside the top five in fewest yards per play five times (2013, 2015, 2019, 2020, 2021).
- X Placing a heavy emphasis on stopping the run, Bowles' defenses have led the NFL in fewest rushing yards allowed per game three times (2014, 2019, 2020).
- X 23 different players have earned Pro Bowl selections with Bowles as their position coach, defensive coordinator or head coach.
- X Enjoyed an eight-year career as an NFL defensive back, playing for Washington (1986-1990, 1992-93) and the San Francisco 49ers.
- X Started 12 games and contributed four interceptions for a Washington team that won Super Bowl XXII.

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Spent three seasons as Tampa Bay's defensive coordinator (2019-21) prior to being promoted to head coach on March 30, 2022.
- X Executed a historic defensive performance in Super Bowl LV, in which the Buccaneers held the Kansas City Chiefs to just nine points and without a touchdown.
- X Bowles has coached five different Buccaneers to Pro Bowl selections: Shaquil Barrett (2019, 2021), Jason Pierre-Paul (2020), Vita Vea (2021), Devin White (2021) and Antoine Winfield Jr. (2021).
- X First Buccaneers coach to begin career 2-0 since Sam Wyche in 1992, and the first to do it with a pair of road wins.
- X Led the NFL's top run defense in back-to-back seasons from 2019-20.
- X In his three seasons as defensive coordinator, Tampa Bay ranked first in fewest rushing yards allowed per game (82.5), first in fewest rushing yards per attempt (3.72), first in quarterback hits (352), first in fumble recoveries (37), first in passes defended (241), second in strip sacks (26), third in tackles for loss (262), third in takeaways (82), third in sacks (142), fourth in forced fumbles (52), tied for fourth in defensive touchdowns (nine), fifth in fewest yards per play allowed (5.13) and fifth in passing yards per attempt allowed (6.78).

TODD BOWLES AT A GLANCE

ANDY REID



Andy Reid is amid his 10th season at the helm of the Chiefs in 2022. He was hired as the club's 13th head coach in franchise history on January 7, 2013.

In his 24th season as an NFL head coach, Reid has amassed 254 total wins, which ranks second among active head coaches, trailing only New England Head Coach Bill Belichick. He added Super Bowl champion to his resume after he led the 2019 squad to a 31-20 come-from-behind win in Super Bowl LIV against San Francisco.

ANDY REID AT A GLANCE

- Since his arrival in Kansas City, Reid's teams have made it to the playoffs eight out of nine seasons, including four consecutive AFC Championship Games (2018-21) and back-to-back Super Bowl appearances (2019-20). In nine seasons under Reid, the Chiefs have recorded eight 10-plus win seasons and a .710 (103-42) winning percentage, which is the top mark in franchise history for any coach in his first nine seasons leading the club.
- Reid's 2021 squad recorded a 12-5 record in the first 17-game season, extended the franchise record to six-straight AFC West titles and secured the No. 2 seed in the AFC. Kansas City defeated Pittsburgh 42-21 in the Wild Card Round and Buffalo 42-36 in the Divisional Round en route to hosting an NFL-record fourth-consecutive AFC Championship Game at GEHA Field at Arrowhead Stadium. The Chiefs fell to Cincinnati 27-24. In Week 4, Reid recorded his 100th victory with Kansas City (postseason included), becoming the first head coach in NFL history to tally 100-plus wins with two franchises.
- Reid joined the Chiefs after 14 seasons as Head Coach/Executive Vice President of Football Operations of the Philadelphia Eagles where he compiled a 130-93-1 (.583) regular season record. Including his years as an assistant coach, Reid's teams have made the playoffs 23 times (28-21 record), and he has coached in five Super Bowls and 12 Championship Games (8 NFC, 4 AFC). He owns three NFL Coach of the Year titles.
- Reid joined Philadelphia as head coach in 1999 and remained in that role through the 2012 season, becoming one of just 11 first-time NFL head coaches to lead 12-or-more seasons with the same club. Reid assumed the additional role of Executive Vice President of Football Operations in 2001.
- While compiling his 10-9 postseason record with Philadelphia, Reid led the Eagles franchise to one Super Bowl appearance. Reid guided Philadelphia to nine playoff appearances during his 14-year tenure.
- In 2008, Reid became the 37th coach to reach the 100-win plateau and the 22nd to win 100 games with one franchise.
- During his seven years with the Packers, Reid served as the tight ends coach and assistant offensive line coach (1992-96) and as quarterbacks coach (1997-98).
- Reid coached collegiately at Missouri, UTEP, Northern Arizona and San Francisco State.
- He played collegiately as an offensive tackle and guard at BYU from 1979-81 before entering the coaching ranks as a graduate assistant at BYU under LaVell Edwards in 1982.
