A CONSISTENTLY-DOMINANT DUO

• In Week 13, Mike Evans reached the 1,000yard mark for the 10th consecutive season - the longest-such streak to begin a career and the second-longest streak overall in league history. Evans is also the first player ever with 60+ receptions in each of his first 10 career seasons.



 \cdot Evans now has five career seasons with 1,000+ receiving yards and 10-or-more receiving touchdowns, which tie him for the fifth-most in NFL history.

Evans and Godwin have accounted for the past three such occasions. Evans and Godwin were 1-of-5 sets of teammates last season to go over 1,000 yards each.

HABITAT HILLSBOROUGH HOME DEDICATION DAY

In December, the Tampa Bay Buccaneers and Habitat for Humanity of Hillsborough saw the work of their community partnership, "Holiday Home Build with the Bucs", come to fruition as they handed over the keys to the four families that will inhabit the homes that they have worked on over the course of the last month. In the last month, Buccaneers players and staff have put in volunteer hours at the homes, installing windows and doors and priming the houses.

Prior to the project's start, over 90% of the Buccaneers roster donated funds towards the construction of a home for a family in need, with the Buccaneers organization matching their contributions to fund the construction of two Habitat homes in the Temple Terrace community. Since then, thanks to donations from the Buccaneers fanbase, coined "The Krewe", as well as comedians Bert Kreischer and Tom Segura, the impact has doubled and now the build of four homes along Overlook Drive has been funded.

The project was part of the player-led Buccaneers Youth Leadership Program, with 25 students apiece from Young Middle Magnet School and Webb Middle School volunteering at the homes as well. The Buccaneers Youth Leadership Program is part of the team's Social Justice Initiative, a player-led program created in 2018 with a \$1,000,000 commitment by the Glazer family to break down barriers to racial and social equality.

- Needs **1 receiving touchdown** to tie himself (14 in 2021) for the franchise record for single-season touchdown receptions.
- Needs 1 total touchdown to tie Eric Dickerson (96) for the 26th-most overall touchdowns in NFL history.
- Needs 2 receiving touchdowns to establish a new franchise record for single-season touchdown receptions.
- Needs 14 points scored to tie Martín Gramática (592) for the most points scored in franchise history.
- Needs 4 receiving touchdowns to tie Cris Carter (1995), Rob Gronkowski (2011), Randy Moss (1998, 2003), Carl Pickens (1995) and Jerry Rice (1989) for the sixth-most singleseason receiving touchdowns in NFL history.
- Needs 5 receiving touchdowns to tie with Don Hutson (99) for the 11th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.

CHRIS GODWIN

- Needs 1 receiving touchdown to surpass Jimmie Giles (34) for the second-most touchdown receptions in team history, trailing only Mike Evans.
- Needs 27 receiving yards to reach the 1,000-yard milestone for the fourth time in his career, breaking a tie with Joey Galloway and Vincent Jackson for the second-most 1,000-yard receiving seasons in team history.
- Needs **3 receptions** to hit the 80-catch mark for the fourth time in his career, extending his current franchise record for suchseasons to four.







- Needs **1 passing touchdown** to surpass Jameis Winston (28 in 2016) for the fourth-most single-season passing touchdowns in team history.
- Needs **2 passing touchdowns** to join Tom Brady as the only players with 30+ passing touchdowns in their first season with Tampa Bay, and just the third player to do it overall for the team.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR



LAVONTE DAVID

- Needs **0.5 sacks** to become just the second player since tackles for loss became regularly tracked in 2008 to record multiple seasons with 100+ tackles, 15+ tackles for loss and 5.0+ sacks, joining Daryl Washington (2011, 2012).
- Needs **3 tackles for loss** to reach 20 tackles for loss on the season and tie Aaron Donald and DeMarcus Ware (3) for the second-most such-seasons since the statistic became regularly tracked in 2008. Only J.J. Watt (4) has more.

RACHAAD WHITE

- Needs 85 rushing yards to become the first Buccaneers running back since Doug Martin in 2015 with 1,000+ rushing yards in a single season. It would mark the 13th-such occurence by a Tampa Bay player in team history.
- Needs 85 rushing yards to join James Wilder (1984) as the only players in franchise history with 1,000+ rushing yards and 500+ receiving yards in a single season. He would also become the first player to accomplish this within his first two seasons since Saquon Barkley and Christian McCaffrey in 2018.
- Needs 54 scrimmage yards to become the first Buccaneers running back since Doug Martin in 2015, and the first Buccaneers player since Mike Evans in 2018, with 1,500+ scrimmage yards in a single season. It would mark the 8th-such occurence by a Tampa Bay player in team history.
- Needs 1 total touchdown to tie five players (10) for the fifthmost single-season touchdowns from scrimmage by a running back in team history.
- Needs 2 total touchdowns to tie Mike Alstott (11 in 2001) and Errict Rhett (11 in 1995) for the third-most single-season touchdowns from scrimmage by a running back in team history.
- Needs 3 total touchdowns to tie Doug Martin (12 in 2012) for the second-most single-season touchdowns from scrimmage by a running back in team history.

- X Spent three seasons as Tampa Bay's defensive coordinator (2019–21) prior to being promoted to head coach on March 30, 2022.
- X Joined Jon Gruden as the only coaches in franchise history to win a division title in their first year as head coach.
- X Executed a historic defensive performance in Super Bowl LV, in which the Buccaneers held the Kansas City Chiefs to just nine points and without a touchdown.
- X Bowles has coached six different Buccaneers to Pro Bowl selections: Shaquil Barrett (2019, 2021), Jason Pierre-Paul (2020), Vita Vea (2021), Devin White (2021), Antoine Winfield Jr. (2021) and Tristan Wirfs (2022).
- X Led the NFL's top run defense in back-toback seasons from 2019-20.

Chris Tabor was named the interim head coach of the Carolina Panthers on November 27, 2023.

Tabor is in his second season as Carolina's special teams coordiantor. He has 26 seasons of coaching experience, including 16 seasons in the NFL.

In his first season in Carolina, he engineered a significant turnaround, helping the Panthers vault up from 28th to fourth in Rick Gosselin's league-wide special teams rankings.

CHRIS TABOR AT A GLANCE

- Kicker Eddy Piñeiro led all qualified NFL kickers with a field goal percentage of 94.3, second-highest in franchise history. Piñeiro's 33 made field goals also ranked second in franchise history. Johnny Hekker led the NFL with a franchise-record 39 punts inside the 20. His net average of 44.12 yards per punt ranked third in the NFL. The Panthers led the league and set a franchise record with four blocked field goals and added a blocked extra point as well.
- Tabor was previously special teams coordinator for the Chicago Bears from 2018-21 and special teams coordinator for the Cleveland Browns from 2011-17. Prior to joining the Browns, Tabor spent three seasons (2008-10) as assistant special teams coach with the Bears.
- Tabor coached a return specialist to the Pro Bowl in each of his last four seasons in Chicago, as the Bears ranked fifth in yards per punt return (10.3) since 2018 and tied for sixth in the NFL with four special teams touchdowns. Chicago had top-10 finishes in total special teams EPA (expected points added) in both 2020 and 2021.
- In 2021, returner Jakeem Grant earned All-Pro and Pro Bowl recognition after ranking third in the NFL with an 11.9-yard average in punt returns.
- In 2020, Cordarelle Patterson led all NFC kick returners for the second-straight season in both kick return average (29.1) and kick return yards (1,017).
- Patterson earned the Pro Bowl nod in 2019 after leading the league in kick return yards, while returner Tarik Cohen was picked for the Pro Bowl in 2018 after leading the league in punt return yards.
- In Cleveland, the Browns were the only team in the NFL to have earned at least one AFC Special Teams Player of the Week award each season from 2011-2016. Kicker Phil Dawson and returner Joshua Cribbs earned Pro Bowl nods in 2012.
- Prior to Chicago, Tabor spent two seasons at Western Michigan University (2006-07) as the running backs and special teams coach. He also spent four seasons at Utah State University (2002-05), where he was the running backs and special teams coach in 2005 after being the Aggies' assistant head coach in charge of wide receivers from 2002-04.
- He was head coach Culver-Stockton College in 2001 and spent time as an assistant at the University of Missouri (1997-99).
- Tabor graduated from Benedictine College in Atchison, Kan., where he played four seasons at quarterback. He earned a master's degree in education from Columbia (Mo.) College. He and his wife, Nikki, have two daughters, Paityn and Lainey.
