FIRST THINGS FIRST

- Friday's matchup will mark the 15th all-time preseason meeting between the Buccaneers and Jaguars, with the Jaguars holding a 9-5 edge in those games.
- Liam Coen will face off against his former team for the first time since taking over as head coach of the Jaguars. Coen served as the offensive coordinator in Tampa Bay in 2024 during a season in which the Buccaneers went 10-7 and claimed the NFC South title.
- Since Bowles took over as head coach in 2022, the Buccaneers have gone 8-6 in the preseason, including going 4-3 in road preseason contests.

PRESEASON NOTES



LIGHTS, CAMERA, JALON

University of Kansas product Jalon Daniels has gone 19-of-29 for 182 yards, including both a passing touchdown and a rushing touchdown, without a turnover, earning a 94.3 passer rating through Week 2 of the preseason. So far, 30 of Tampa Bay's 33 offensive points scored this preseason have come with Daniels leading the drive.

In Preseason Week 1, he became the first quarterback to score a rushing touchdown for the Buccaneers in the preseason since Ryan Fitzpatrick on 8/11/17 at Cincinnati. He was the only quarterback in Week 1 with 100+ passing yards and a rushing touchdown.

A DAZZLING DEBUT

In his first NFL action, undrafted rookie CB Ayden Garnes recorded Tampa Bay's first touchdown of the 2026 preseason via a 47-yard interception return in Week 1.

Garnes' 47-yard return was the longest by a Buccaneers player since TruMedia preseason data became available in 2017. It was 1-of-2 interception return touchdowns across the league in Preseason Week 1, and the only one by an undrafted player.

Through Preseason Week 2, Garnes is tied for fifth in the NFL with two passes defended.

PACKING THE PRESSURE

After Head Coach Todd Bowles placed an emphasis on getting to the quarterback in 2026, the team has responded with 6.0 sacks through Preseason Week 2, which are tied for the third-most across the NFL.

Tampa Bay's defense also ranks tied for second in interceptions (three), tied for fourth in takeaways (three) and tied for fifth in fewest opponent touchdowns (two).

Mayfield rushed for a career-high 382 yards in 2025. He carried the ball 29 times on third down, with 21 going for first downs (72.4% success rate). That was the second-highest first-down rush percentage on third-down attempts among all quarterbacks with 15+ third-down carries and the fourth-highest mark in the entire NFL. Mayfield's 259 rushing yards on third down led the entire NFL in 2025.

On his way to the fifth-best third-down rushing success rate in the league, **Mayfield** did it by extending plays and picking up extensive yardage. His 8.9 yards per rush on third down were the second-most among qualified players and his 6.9 yards per rush overall led all quarterbacks in 2025.

5X PRO BOWL LEFT TACKLE TRISTAN WIRFS IS WORTH EVERY PENNY

Tristan Wirfs was selected for the 2026 Pro Bowl Games, earning his fifth consecutive nod (2021-25). His five Pro Bowl selections are the third-most by an offensive player in team history, trailing only Mike Alstott and Mike Evans (six each).

Wirfs was the only offensive lineman in 2025 to have finished top five in each offensive, run blocking and pass blocking grades per Pro Football Focus.

Chase McLaughlin reset the Buccaneers single-season franchise record for field goal percentage in consecutive seasons, posting a 93.5% clip in 2023 and following that up with a 93.8% mark in 2024. He also set a franchise record by making 30 consecutive field goals from 10/26/23 to 10/21/24 and has made the **most field goals made of 50+ yards in team history (26)**, including an **11-for-11 stretch on 50+ yard field goal attempts in 2025, which set a new record for the longest streak within a season without a miss in league history**. His 65-yarder in Week 4 was the then **longest outdoor field goal in NFL history** and remains the **longest made field goal in franchise history**.

Last year with the Pittsburgh Steelers, Gainwell eclipsed the 1,000 scrimmage yards mark for the first time in his career. He was the lone running back across the league last season to reach that mark on fewer than 200 touches (187).
