· Tom Brady finished his first season in Tampa Bay with 40 touchdown passes (the most ever by a player in his first season with a team) and 4,633 passing yards (the second-most ever by a player in his first season with a team). Over his last eight quarters of regular season football, Brady



threw for 1,067 yards and 10 touchdowns with just one interception.







HC BRUCE ARIANS

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X In addition to leading the Buccaneers to a Super Bowl LV title in 2020, Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on Jan 8, 2019.
- X In 2020, Arians led Tampa Bay to 11 wins, tying its second-most in team history. The Buccaneers also clinched their first playoff berth since 2007 and won the franchise's second Super Bowl. Arians' team ranked first in rush defense, third in scoring, fourth in pass offense, sixth in total defense and seventh in total offense.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X In 2019, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense and ranking third in the NFL in total offense. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL singlegame rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

David Culley was named head coach of the Houston Texans on Jan. 29, 2021, becoming the fourth head coach in franchise history. Culley joins the Texans from the Baltimore Ravens where he served the last two seasons (2019-20) as the assistant head coach / pass coordinator / wide receivers coach. Culley owns 27 years of NFL coaching experience and 43 overall in coaching after a 16-year career on the collegiate level. As an NFL coach, Culley has captured 10 division titles, made the playoffs in 17 different seasons and appeared in six conference championship games.

DAVID CULLEY AT A GLANCE

- As the Ravens assistant head coach / pass coordinator / wide receivers coach from 2019-20, Culley assisted the Ravens offense in creating a passing scheme that complemented the team's dynamic rushing attack. In 2020, Culley helped an offense post the seventh-most points per game (29.3) in the league.
- In 2019, Culley helped a Ravens offense that led the NFL in scoring at 33.2 points per game. His coaching yielded a unit that ranked second in the league in total yards per game (407.6), while also setting team records for touchdowns (64), points (531), net yards (6,521), rushing yards (3,296), first downs (386) and fewest turnovers (15).
- Prior to joining the Ravens, Culley spent 2017-18 as the quarterbacks coach for the Bills. In 2018, he helped develop QB Josh Allen, who posted the franchise record for the most total touchdowns (18) produced by a Bills rookie quarterback. Additionally, Allen set franchise quarterback records for the most rushing yards in a game (135), single-season rushing touchdowns (eight) and single-season rushing yards (631). Culley also worked with QB Tyrod Taylor in 2017 when he completed 62.6 percent of his passes for 2,799 yards, 14 touchdowns and just four interceptions. Taylor would go on to lead Buffalo to a 9-7 season, resulting in the franchise's first playoff berth since 1999.
- Culley served as the assistant head coach / wide receivers coach with the Chiefs from 2013-16, where he helped guide the Chiefs to three playoff appearances and a cumulative record of 43-21.
- Culley spent 14 seasons with the Eagles (1999-2012) as the
 wide receivers coach from 1999-2010 and as a senior offensive
 assistant / wide receivers coach in 2011-12. During his tenure,
 Philadelphia made nine playoff appearances, advancing to five
 NFC Championship games and one Super Bowl (XXXIX).
- In 2009-10, the Eagles made the playoffs in consecutive seasons and won the NFC East Division title in 2010. Culley worked closely with WR DeSean Jackson during the two seasons and helped him earn the first two Pro Bowl selections of his career. Jackson totaled consecutive 1,000-yard receiving seasons and notched a league-high 22.5 yards per reception average in 2010.
- Under Culley's coaching in 2004, WR Terrell Owens earned First-Team All-Pro honors when he posted 77 receptions for 1,200 yards (15.6 avg.) and a franchise-record 14 receiving touchdowns.
- Prior to coaching in the NFL, Culley had multiple coaching stops in college over a 16-year span.
