### A CONSISTENTLY-DOMINANT DUO

· Mike Evans (1,124) and Chris Godwin (1,023) each surpassed the 1,000-yard receiving mark last season, marking the fourth time in franchise history that multiple Buccaneers surpassed the 1,000-yard mark in the same season (2014, 2019, 2021, 2022). Evans and Godwin have accounted for the past three such occasions.



 $\cdot$  Evans and Godwin were 1-of-5 sets of teammates last season to go over 1,000 yards each.

### **SOLID UP FRONT**

· Since the start of the 2020 season, Tampa Bay ranks first in sacks allowed per pass attempt (3.1%) and leads the NFL in most games without allowing a sack (16). Led by Pro Bowl tackle Tristan Wirfs, the Buccaneers finished first in the NFL in 2022 in both fewest sacks allowed (22) and fewest sacks per pass attempt (2.8%).

# DEFENSIVE NOTES

### RE-EMPHASIZING THE RUN GAME

**Team** 



- The Buccaneers defense has put a priority on stopping the run and it showed in the team's 20-17 win over Minnesota in Week 1 as Tampa Bay allowed just 41 yards rushing on 17 carries (2.4 avg.).
- $\cdot$  In addition, the average distance of first contact with Minnesota's rusher came almost a half-yard behind the line of scrimmage the lowest yards before contact per rush average in the NFL in Week 1.

### TALLY UP THE TAKEAWAYS



· The Buccaneers defense had three takeaways in Week 1 and has been one of the league's best at creating turnovers since **Todd Bowles** took over the defense in 2019. From the start of the 2019 season, Tampa Bay ranks fifth in takeaways and tied for first in points off turnovers.

#### STEPPING UP IN THE SECONDARY



· Antoine Winfield Jr. recorded a sack, forced fumble and a fumble recovery in Tampa Bay's Week 1 win over his father's former team, the Minnesota Vikings.

• **Winfield Jr.** is the only defensive back since at least 2000 with 10+ sacks, five-or-more forced

fumbles and five-or-more fumble recoveries in their first four career seasons. His 10.0 sacks since entering the league in 2020 are the most by a defensive back in the NFL during that span.

- **Winfield Jr.** is the first defensive back with a sack, forced fumble and fumble recovery in the same game since Jamal Adams in 2019 and the only DB to do so for Tampa Bay since at least 2000.
- In his NFL debut, undrafted rookie defensive back **Christian Izien** picked off Kirk Cousins on the goal line to record his first career interception. Izien is the first Buccaneers player since 2010 to record an interception in his first career game, and just the fourth to do so in franchise history (excludes 1987 replacement players).
- **Izien** is the first undrafted Buccaneers rookie to intercept a pass in a Week 1 NFL debut since Cecil Johnson in the franchise's second season in 1977.


### MIKE EVANS

- Needs **1 receiving touchdown** to tie Antonio Brown, Calvin Johnson and Brandon Marshall (83) for the 25th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs 2 receiving touchdowns to tie Mark Clayton, Tommy McDonald, Irving Fryar and Andre Rison (84) for the 21st-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs 3 receiving touchdowns to tie Lance Alworth, Jimmy Graham, Hines Ward and Paul Warfield (85) for the 17th-most touchdown receptions in NFL history.
- Needs 1 start to surpass Mike Alstott (137) for the sixth-most games started in franchise history.
- Needs 24 receiving yards to surpass A.J. Green (10,514) for the 44th-most receiving yards in NFL history.
- Needs 81 receiving yards to surpass Keyshawn Johnson (10,571) for the 43rd-most receiving yards in NFL history.

### **CHRIS GODWIN**

- Needs 1 receiving touchdown to tie Cameron Brate (33) for the third-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Needs 2 receiving touchdowns to tie Jimmie Giles (34) for the second-most touchdown receptions in team history.
- Needs 1 touchdown to tie Jimmie Giles (34) for the fourth-most touchdowns from scrimmage in franchise history.
- Needs 5 receptions to surpass Keyshawn Johnson (15) for the longest streak of games with 5-or-more receptions in franchise history and tie Marvin Harrison (16) for the 13th-longest such streak in NFL history.





### **ADDITIONAL NOTES**

- CB **Christian Izien** needs **1 interception** to become just the fourth undrafted player in NFL history with an interception in each of his first two career games, and the first since 2013.
- WR **Trey Palmer** needs **1 touchdown reception** to become just the third player in team history with a receiving touchdown in each of his first two career games, and the first since Mike Williams in 2010.

### 'AMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Spent three seasons as Tampa Bay's defensive coordinator (2019-21) prior to being promoted to head coach on March 30, 2022.
- X Joined Jon Gruden as the only coaches in franchise history to win a division title in their first year as head coach.
- X Executed a historic defensive performance in Super Bowl LV, in which the Buccaneers held the Kansas City Chiefs to just nine points and without a touchdown.
- X Bowles has coached six different Buccaneers to Pro Bowl selections: Shaquil Barrett (2019, 2021), Jason Pierre-Paul (2020), Vita Vea (2021), Devin White (2021), Antoine Winfield Jr. (2021) and Tristan Wirfs (2022).
- X Led the NFL's top run defense in back-toback seasons from 2019-20.
- X In his three seasons as defensive coordinator, Tampa Bay ranked first in fewest rushing yards allowed per game (82.5), first in fewest rushing vards per attempt (3.72), first in quarterback hits (352), first in fumble recoveries (37), first in passes defensed (241), second in strip sacks (26), third in tackles for loss (262), third in takeaways (82), third in sacks (142), fourth in forced fumbles (52), tied for fourth in defensive touchdowns (nine), fifth in fewest yards per play allowed (5.13) and fifth in passing yards per attempt allowed (6.78).

# MATT EBERFLUS



Matt Eberflus was named the 17th head coach in Chicago's franchise history on January 27th, 2022.

Eberflus entered the 2023 season with 31 years of coaching experience.

In his first season as head coach, Eberflus' partnership with Ryan Poles was instrumental in the organization's restructure of the club's staff, roster and overall culture.

### MATT EBERFLUS AT A GLANCE

- On the offensive side of the ball, the Bears finished the 2022 season with record-setting rushing performances from quarterback Justin Fields, while also setting a team franchise rushing record with a league-high 3,019 rushing yards - the most ever by a Bears offense since the start of the 1920 NFL season.
- Defensively, Eberflus helped guide the youngest on-field roster in the NFL, as Bears defensive rookies led all teams with 3,538 total snaps. Despite a young roster, the Bears defense finished the season top 10 in completions allowed (323, sixth), interception percentage (2.9%, eighth) and fourth down conversions (six, first).
- In his four seasons as defensive coordinator in Indianapolis, the Colts were the only NFL defensive unit to be ranked in the top-10 in scoring, run defense and takeaways in each of the past two seasons. The Colts finished in the top-10 in the NFL in run defense and takeaways in all four of his years, top-10 in scoring defense in three of the four and were the least penalized defense in the league in 2019 and 2021.
- His previous NFL stops included spending seven years with the Dallas Cowboys as linebackers coach (2011-15) and later elevating to linebackers coach/passing game coordinator (2016-17). He entered the NFL as a linebackers coach for the Cleveland Browns (2009-10).
- Previously, Eberflus spent 17 years coaching at the collegiate level with stops at his alma mater, Toledo (1992-2000), and Missouri (2001-08). With the Tigers, Eberflus ascended to the role of defensive coordinator/associate head coach.
- As a player, Eberflus was a four-year letterman and three-year starting linebacker at Toledo. He earned first-team All-MAC honors and led his team in tackles as both a junior and a senior. As a senior, he was voted team captain and was awarded the Nicholson Award as the team's Most Valuable Player. Eberflus earned a degree in education in 1993 and was inducted into Toledo's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2004.
- · He and his wife, Kelly, have two daughters, Grace and Giada.






