· Tom Brady finished his first season in Tampa Bay with 40 touchdown passes (the most ever by a player in his first season with a team) and 4,633 passing yards (the second-most ever by a player in his first season with a team). **Brady currently leads the NFL with 10 touchdown passes and ranks second in passing yards.**

Buccaneers Defensive Coordinator Todd Bowles inherited the league's 27th-ranked defense. Since joining Tampa Bay, Bowles completely transformed the team's defensive unit, finishing as the league's sixth-ranked defense in 2020.

- Patriots K **Nick Folk** appeared in four games with the Buccaneers in 2017.

FORMER PATRIOTS

- Buccaneers QB **Tom Brady** spent the first 20 seasons of his NFL career with the Patriots (2000-19) after being drafted 199th overall in the 2000 NFL Draft. Over his 20 seasons with New England, Brady compiled a 219-64 record (.773), while leading the franchise to nine Super Bowl appearances and six Super Bowl titles. Brady also won three league MVP awards and four Super Bowl MVP honors, while earning 14 Pro Bowl selections and three first-team All-Pro honors. Brady holds many franchise records for the Patriots, including both passing yards (74,571) and passing touchdowns (541).
- Buccaneers TE **Rob Gronkowski** spent the first nine years of his NFL career with the New England Patriots (2010-18) after being selected with the No. 42 overall pick in the second round of the 2010 NFL Draft. Gronkowski played in 115 games with New England, including 100 starts, recording 521 receptions for 7,861 yards and 79 touchdowns in the regular season. He was a member of four Super Bowl teams with the Patriots, while earning five Pro Bowl selections and four first-team All-Pro honors. He is New England's all-time leader in both scrimmage touchdowns (80) and receiving touchdowns (79).
- Buccaneers GM **Jason Licht** joined the Patriots starting as a college scout and worked his way up to director of player personnel (1999-2002, 2009-11).

HC BRUCE ARIANS

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- X In addition to leading the Buccaneers to a Super Bowl LV title in 2020, Arians is a two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year, earning the award in 2012 (Indianapolis Colts) and in 2014 (Arizona Cardinals).
- X He is the only coach in NFL history to earn the award multiple times in a three-year span with different teams and is one of only 12 coaches in NFL history to win the award multiple times.
- X Prior to his time with the Colts, Arians spent eight seasons with the Steelers, five as offensive coordinator (2007-11) and three as the wide receivers coach (2004-06). During his tenure as the offensive coordinator, the Steelers had a 55-25 record, tying Green Bay for the second-best mark in the NFL during that span.
- X Pittsburgh won three AFC North Division titles, two AFC Championships and earned a victory in Super Bowl XLIII over the Cardinals. Arians was also part of the Steelers' Super Bowl XL win as the team's wide receivers coach.

ARIZONA CARDINALS

- X During his time in Arizona, Arians compiled a 49-30-1 regular season record (.619 winning percentage). The Cardinals' 49 wins during that span were the seventh-most in the NFL and the third-most in the NFC. Arians won 50 total games in Arizona (49 regular season, one postseason), finishing as the winningest coach in franchise history. His 49 regular season wins are also the most by any coach in Cardinals history.
- X In 2015, Arians led the Cardinals to a franchise record 13 wins, which also featured the team's first-ever postseason bye and second-ever appearance in the NFC Championship Game.
- X Under Arians, the Cardinals offense set several single-season team records, including points scored (489 in 2015), total touchdowns (59 in 2015), total net yards (6,533 in 2015) and first downs (373 in 2015).

TAMPA BAY BUCCANEERS

- X Bruce Arians was named the 12th head coach in franchise history on Jan 8, 2019.
- X In 2020, Arians led Tampa Bay to 11 wins, tying its second-most in team history. The Buccaneers also clinched their first playoff berth since 2007 and won the franchise's second Super Bowl. Arians' team ranked first in rush defense, third in scoring, fourth in pass offense, sixth in total defense and seventh in total offense.
- X In his first season with the Buccaneers in 2019, Arians led Tampa Bay to a two-win improvement over the previous season, guiding the team to a 5-3 record over the last eight games to finish 7-9. The Buccaneers 5-3 record on the road matched the third-best road mark in team history.
- X In 2019, Tampa Bay's offense set franchise records for both points scored (458) and touchdowns (54), while leading the league in passing offense and ranking third in the NFL in total offense. On the defensive side of the ball, the Buccaneers boasted the NFL's best run defense, limiting opponents to 1,181 rushing yards over 16 games (73.8 avg.), the lowest total allowed in a 16-game season in franchise history.

INDIANAPOLIS COLTS

- X Arians went to Arizona after spending the 2012 season with Indianapolis. Hired as the team's offensive coordinator, he also served as the team's interim head coach for 12 games while head coach Chuck Pagano was treated for leukemia. He led the Colts to a 9-3 record and was selected as the 2012 AP NFL Coach of the Year. Indianapolis' nine-win improvement (2-14 to 11-5) matched the third-largest single-season turnaround in NFL history.
- X Arians helped the Colts' offense rank 10th in the NFL in yards (362.4 ypg) and seventh in passing yards (258.0 ypg). Rookie quarterback Andrew Luck - the first overall pick in the 2012 NFL Draft - made the Pro Bowl and set rookie records for passing yards (4,374) and 300-yard passing games (six). He also established the NFL single-game rookie record for passing yards (433, 11/4 vs. Miami). Luck finished with the then-third-most passing touchdowns by a rookie in NFL history, with 23.

BILL BELICHICK



Bill Belichick completed his 46th season as an NFL coach in 2020 and is in his 22nd season as head coach of the New England Patriots. Belichick is the only head coach in NFL history to win six Super Bowl titles. In 2018, Belichick won his sixth Super Bowl, joining George Halas and Curly Lambeau as the only NFL coaches with six championships. He enters his 47th consecutive year as an NFL coach in 2021, the most consecutive seasons as an NFL coach. Pro Football Hall of Famer Dick LeBeau (45) is second. The only other NFL coach with at least 40 consecutive NFL coaching seasons is Buccaneers Assistant Coach Tom Moore, with 41.

BILL BELICHICK AT A GLANCE

- Through 2020, Belichick owns the most wins among all active coaches and ranks third all-time with 311 total victories as a head coach. Belichick's winning percentage of .678 ranks second in NFL history among coaches with 150 or more wins to the .682 by George Halas.
- He led the Patriots to a winning record for 19 consecutive seasons (2001-19), trailing only Dallas' Tom Landry, who recorded 20 consecutive winning seasons from 1966-85.
- Belichick has notched 31 postseason wins in his career, most by a head coach in NFL history.
- In 21 seasons, Belichick has delivered six Super Bowl championships, nine conference titles, 17 division crowns (with 2002 and 2008 lost on tiebreakers) and 31 playoff victories, while posting an overall record of 281-138.
- In 2019, the Patriots won their 11th consecutive division championship, extending their NFL record previously held by the L.A. Rams (1973-79).
- Belichick directed the Patriots to victories in Super Bowls XXXVI (2001), XXXVIII (2003), XXXIX (2004), XLIX (2014), LI (2016) and LIII (2018), and in 2007 he became the only NFL head coach to guide his team to a 16-0 regular season. From 2003 to 2004, Belichick coached the Patriots to a winning streak of 21 consecutive games, including the postseason.
- In 2018, Belichick joined Marv Levy (4) and Don Shula (3) as the only NFL head coaches to lead their team to three consecutive Super Bowl appearances.
- From 2000-19, the Patriots won 74 percent of their regular-season games (267-94), the highest winning percentage of any major American professional sports team over that span.
- Additionally, Belichick is the first head coach in NFL history to lead a team to three straight 500-point seasons (2010-12) and the Patriots are the first franchise in NFL history to score 500 or more points in four seasons (2007-589, 2010-518, 2011-513 and 2012-557).
- In the victory over the Cleveland Browns at home on Oct. 27, 2019, Belichick became the third head coach in NFL history to win 300 games, doing so in his 434th NFL game, faster than Don Shula (445 games) and George Halas (455 games).
